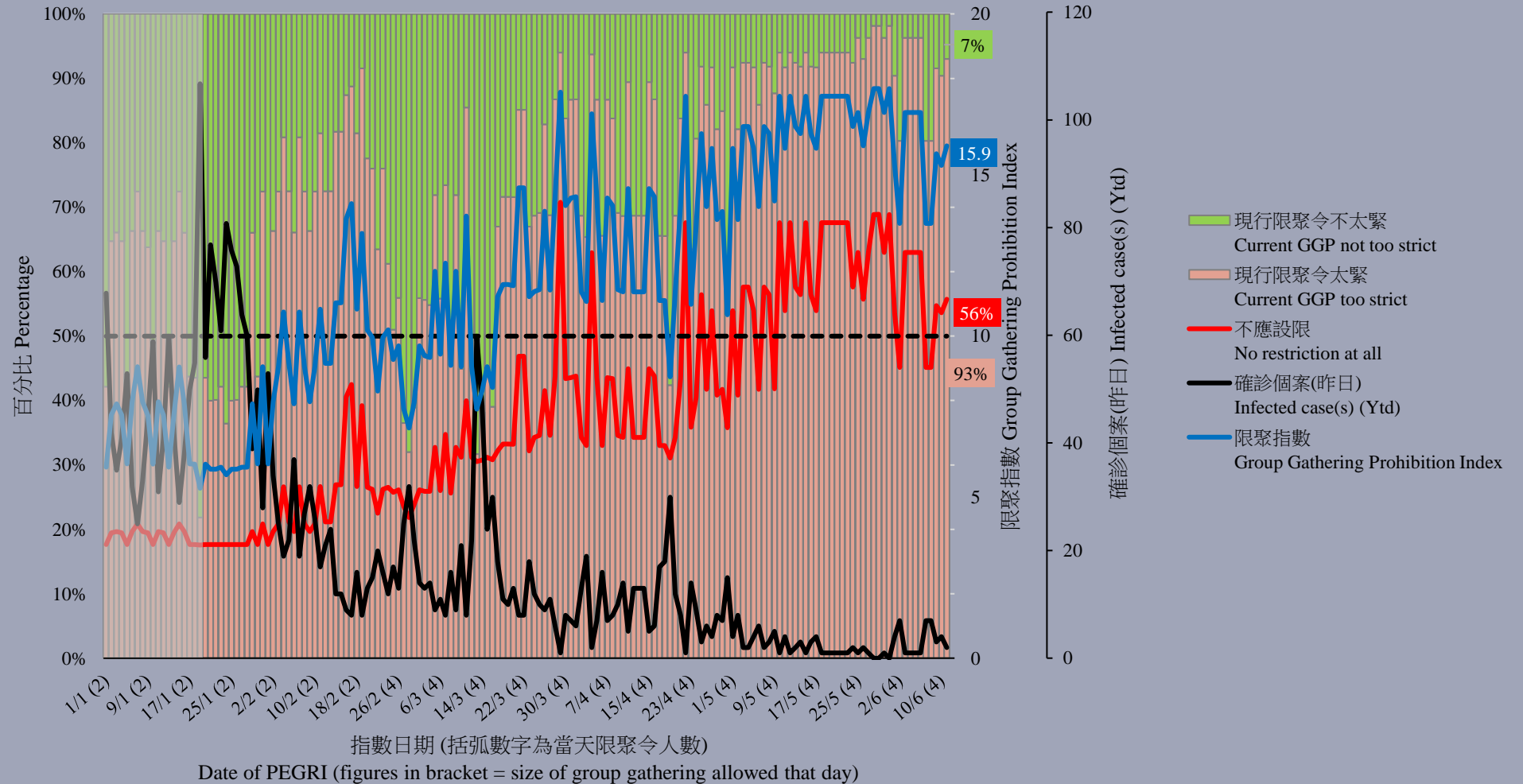

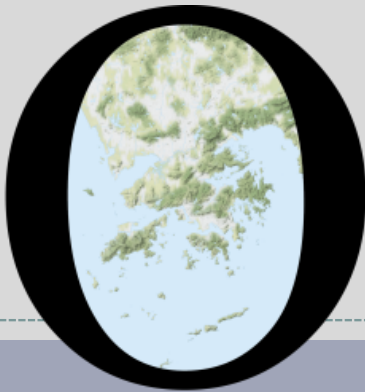
Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

中科監察研究員潘麒智指出：「政府嚴格把關，堵截變種病毒傳入本港，策略算是非常成功。所以，限聚令應可進一步放寬，提升現時的限聚人數。不過，飲食業界就非常不滿政府有關ABCD區的安排，認為是設計混亂、欠缺邏輯、政策離地。由4月29日到今天，只有極少數業界能做到D區的安排。這樣，飲食業將面對更大的倒閉風險。我建議政府從善如流，馬上調整現行政策，勿再執迷不悟。」

KC Poon, researcher from the CHINAT Monitor, observed, “The government has been very successful in preventing the mutated virus from entering Hong Kong through foreign visitors. It is time to relax the group gathering ban by raising the gathering limit. However, the catering industry is very unhappy with the government’s arrangement for ABCD zones. They think the design is confusing, illogical and impractical. Since 29 April, only a minority of the industry has been able to set up D Zones. The catering industry is now facing a greater risk of collapse. I suggest the government to follow the public’s wish to adjust its policies without delay.”

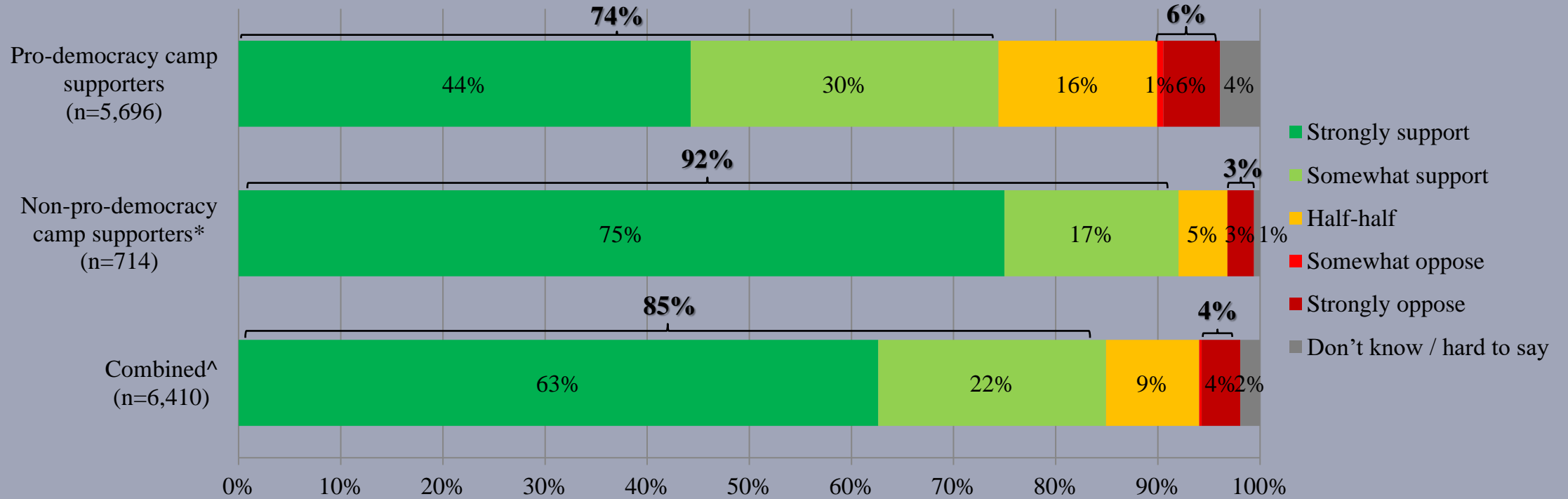

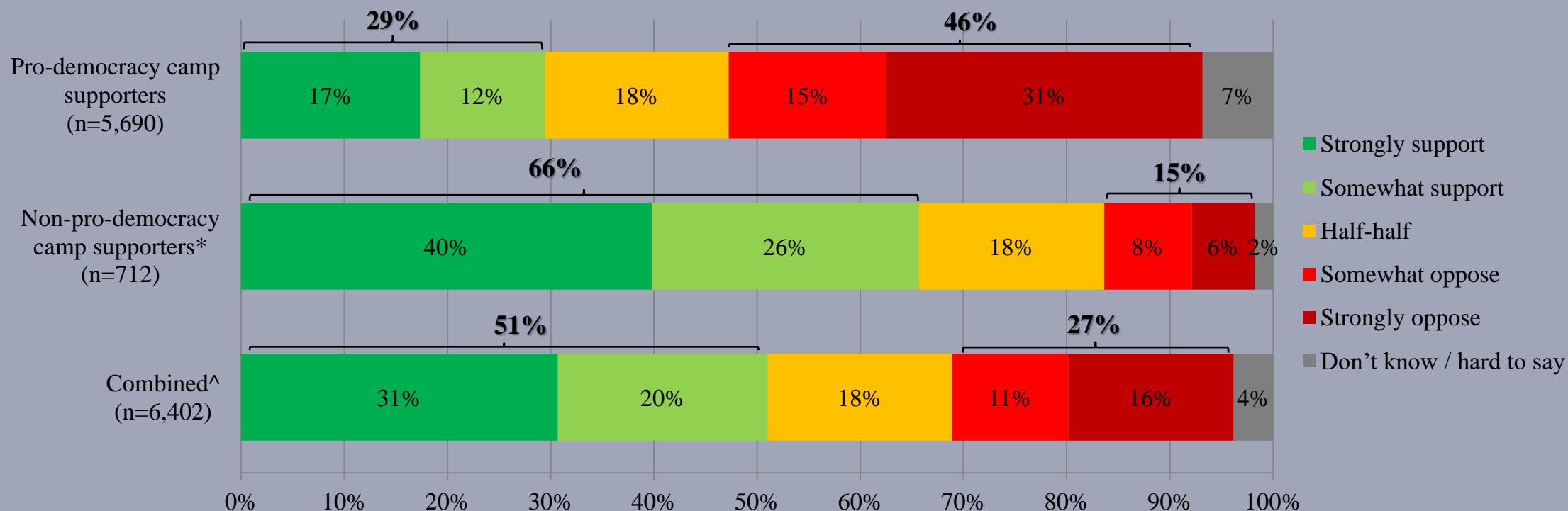

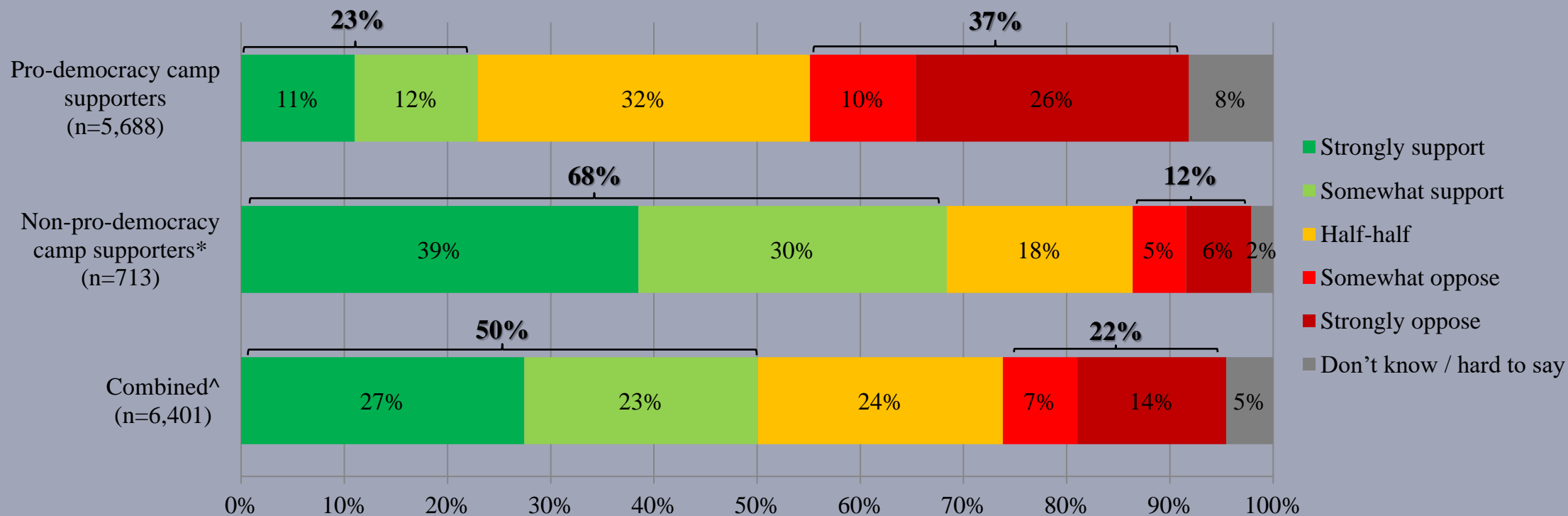

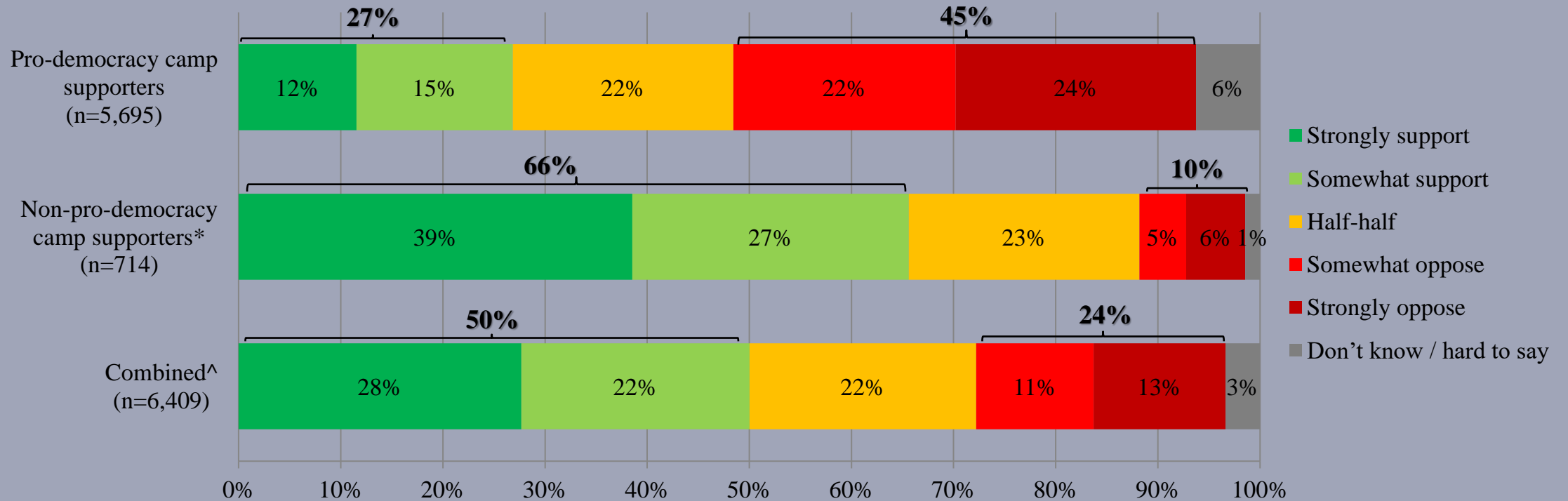

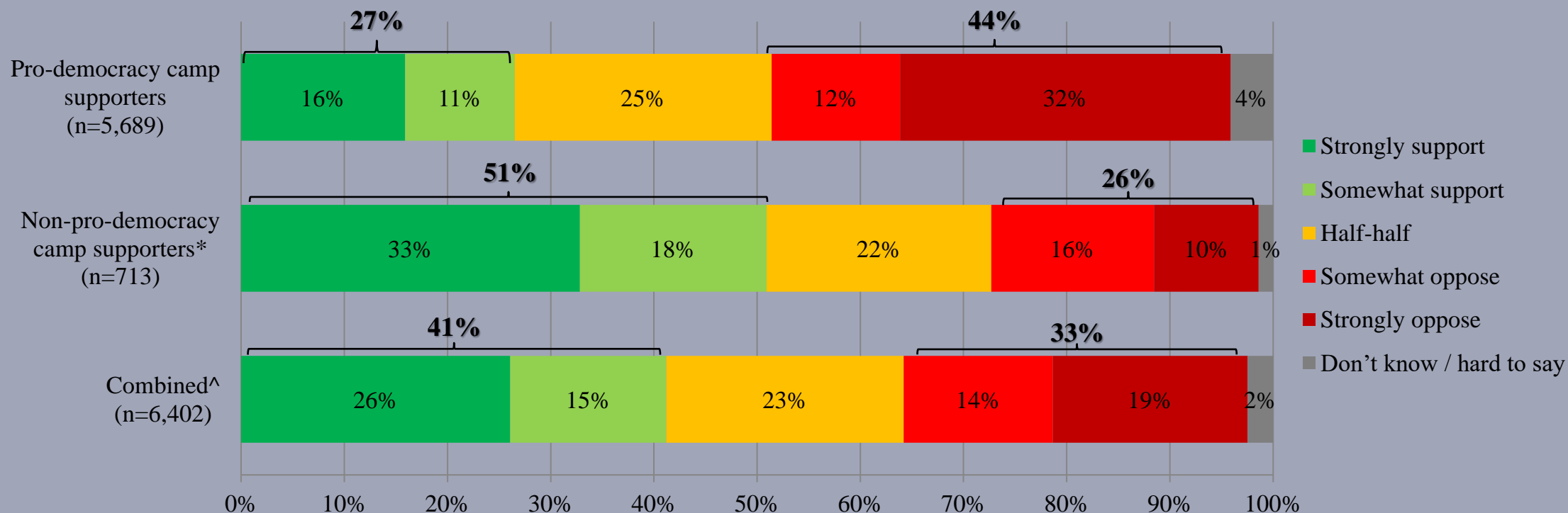

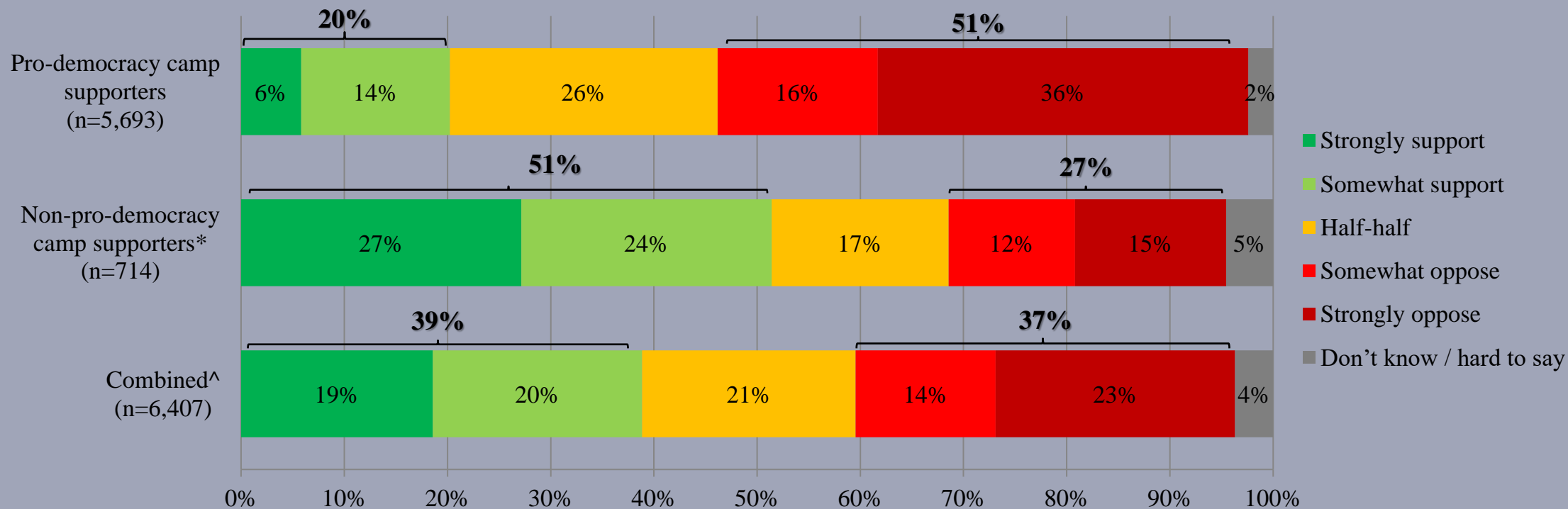

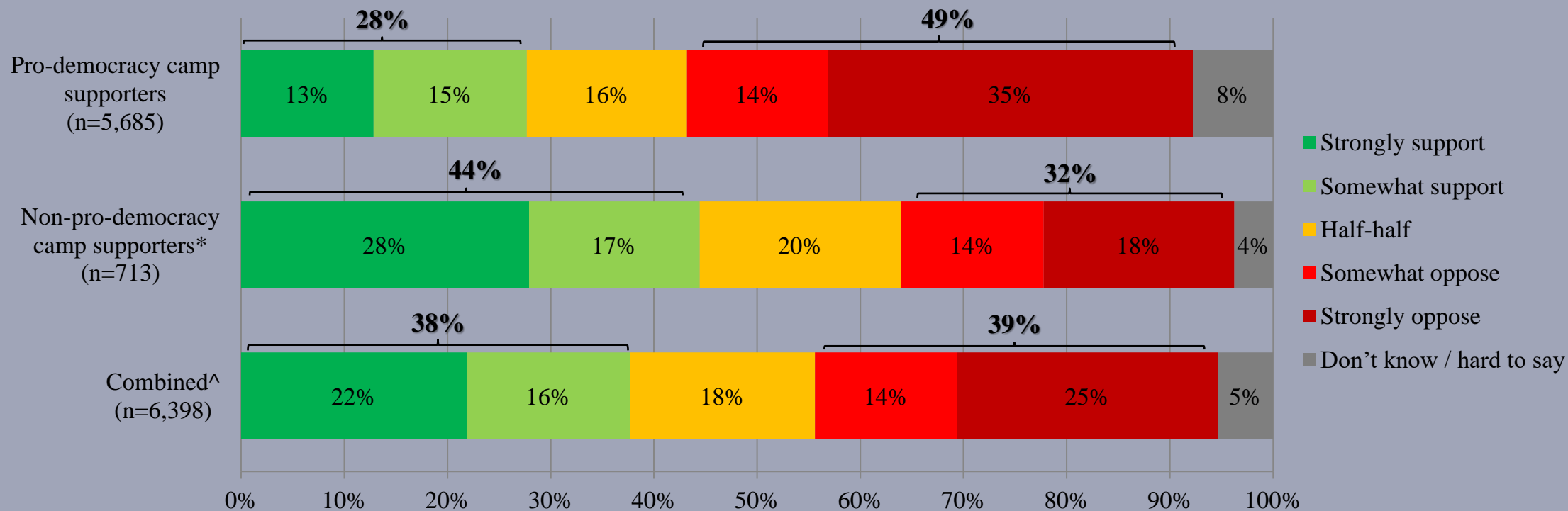

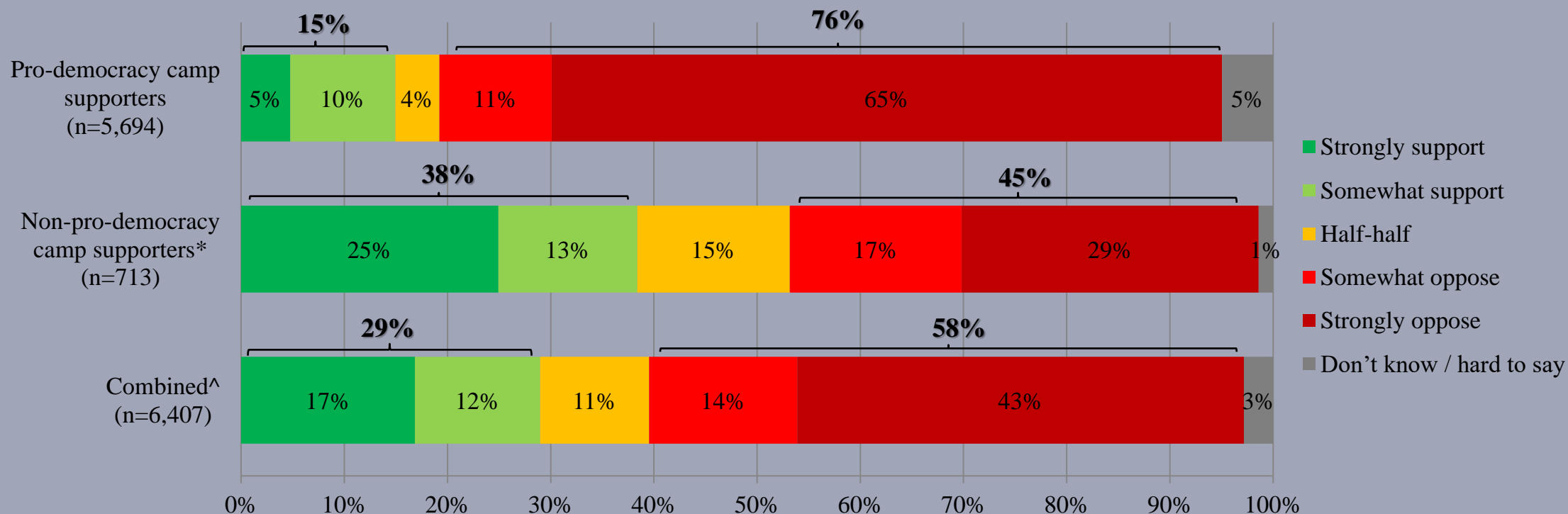

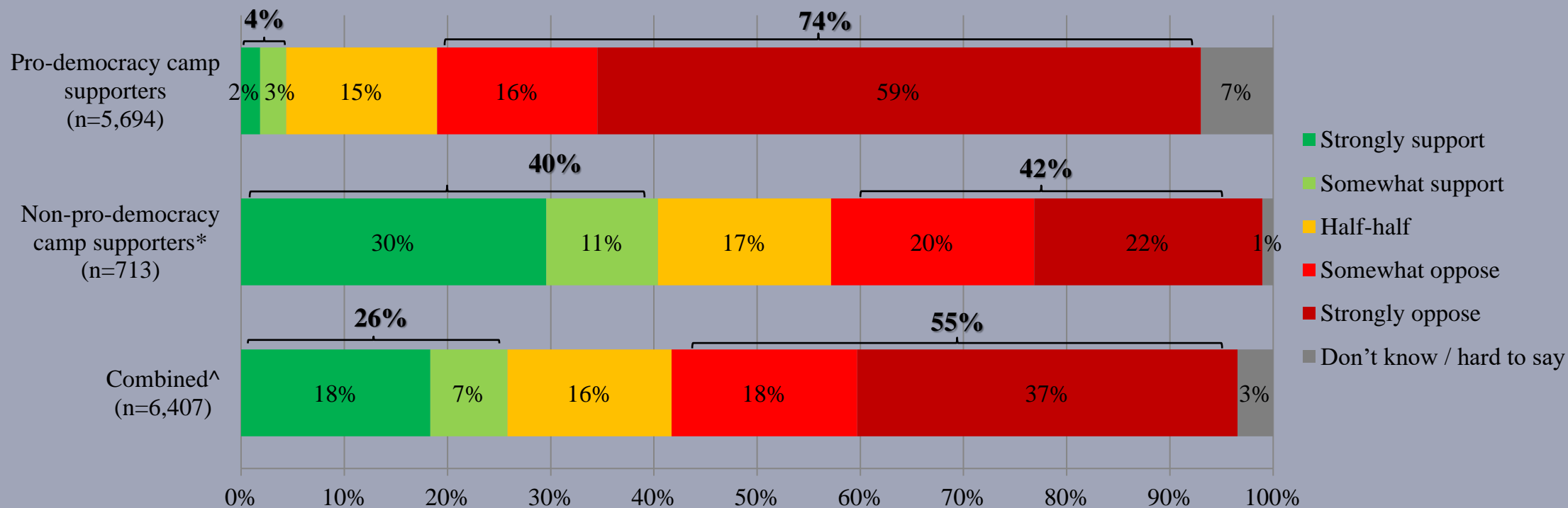
