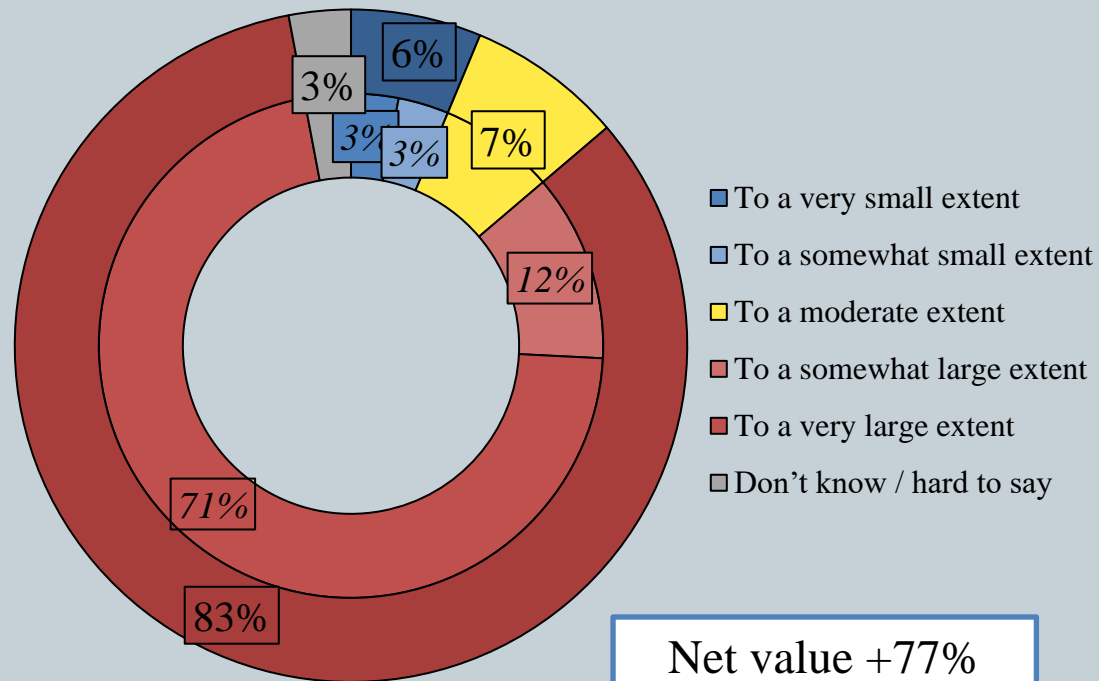

12-14/11/19	858	204	206	448	87.8%
12-15/11/19	1183	306	297	580	86.6%
18/11/19	544	135	131	278	79.8%
18-19/11/19	1067	265	268	534	82.5%

- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers, plus telephone and online interviews with POP Panel samples
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong citizens aged 18+
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-3%, that of net values not more than +/-6% at 95% confidence level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted by day according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2018”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2018 Edition)”.

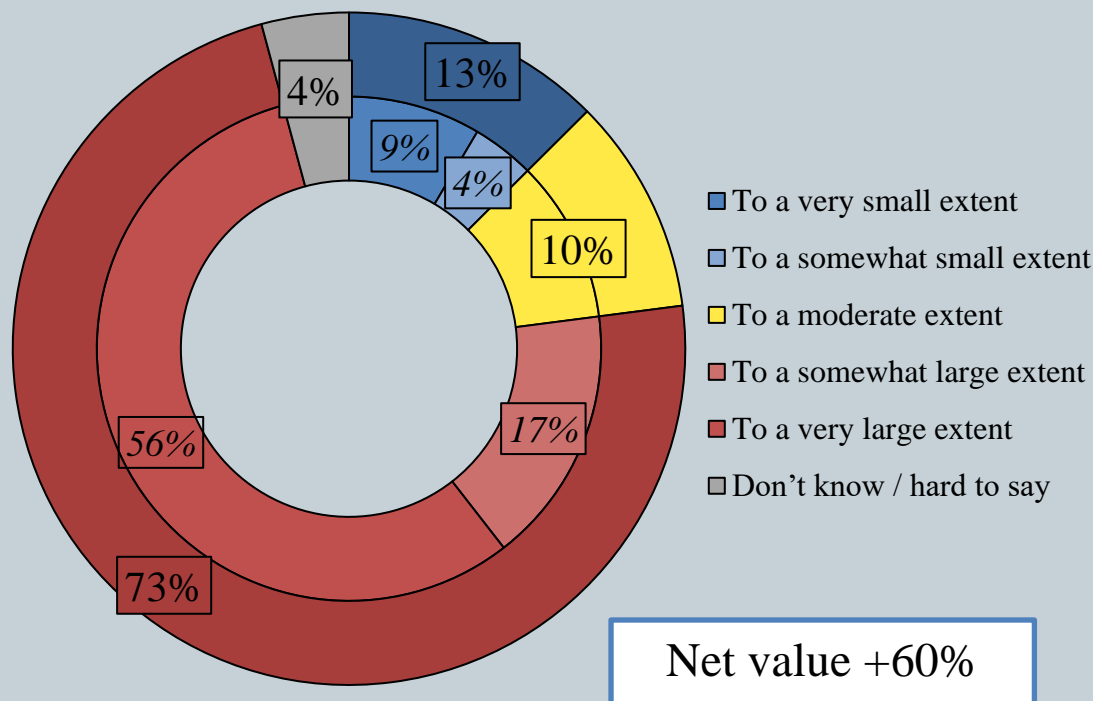

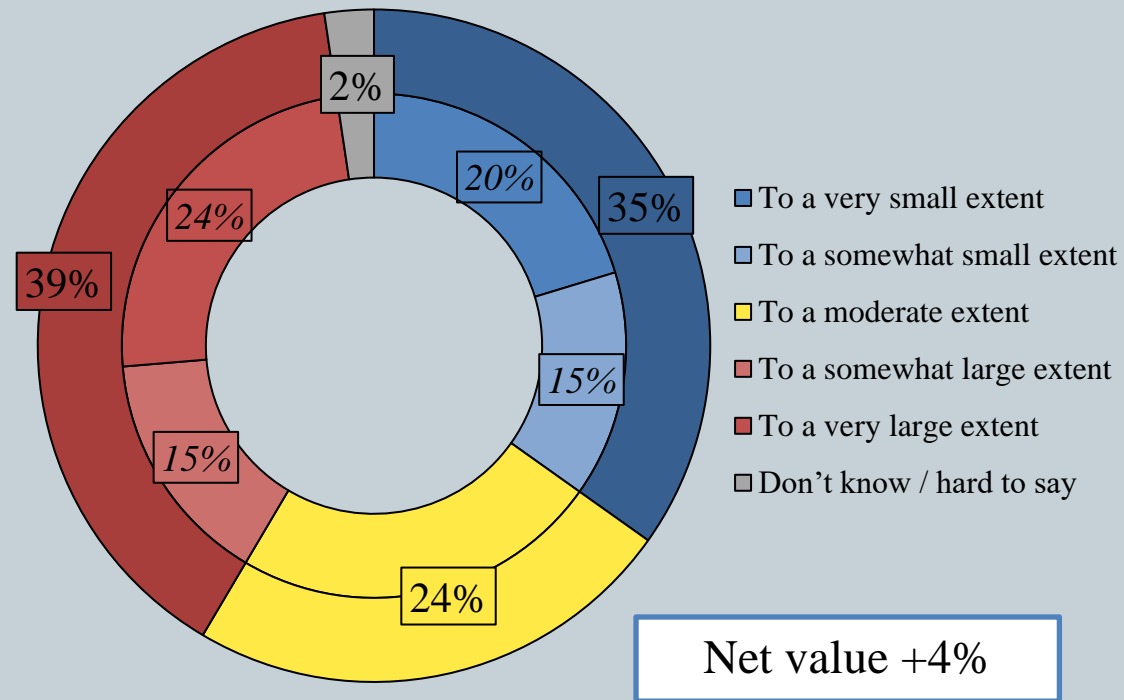

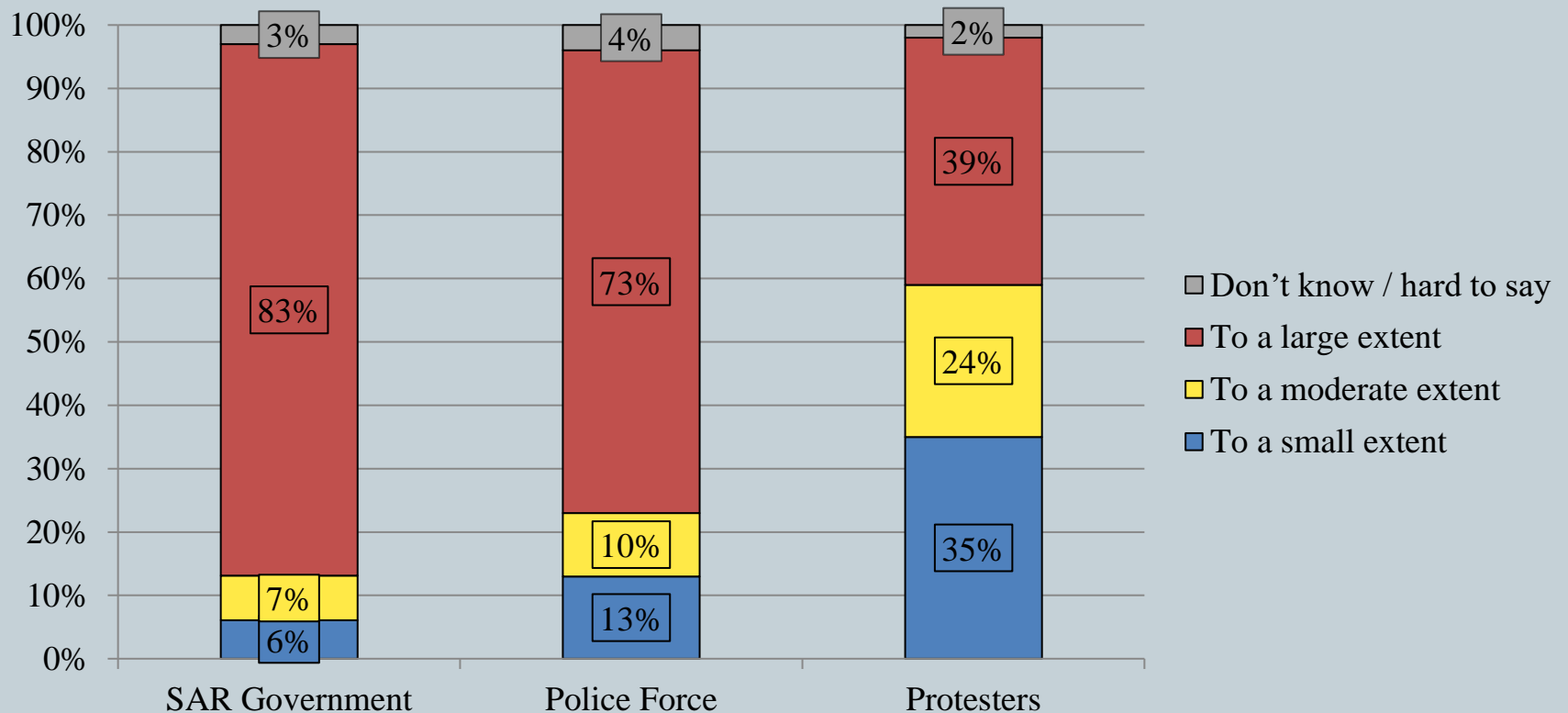

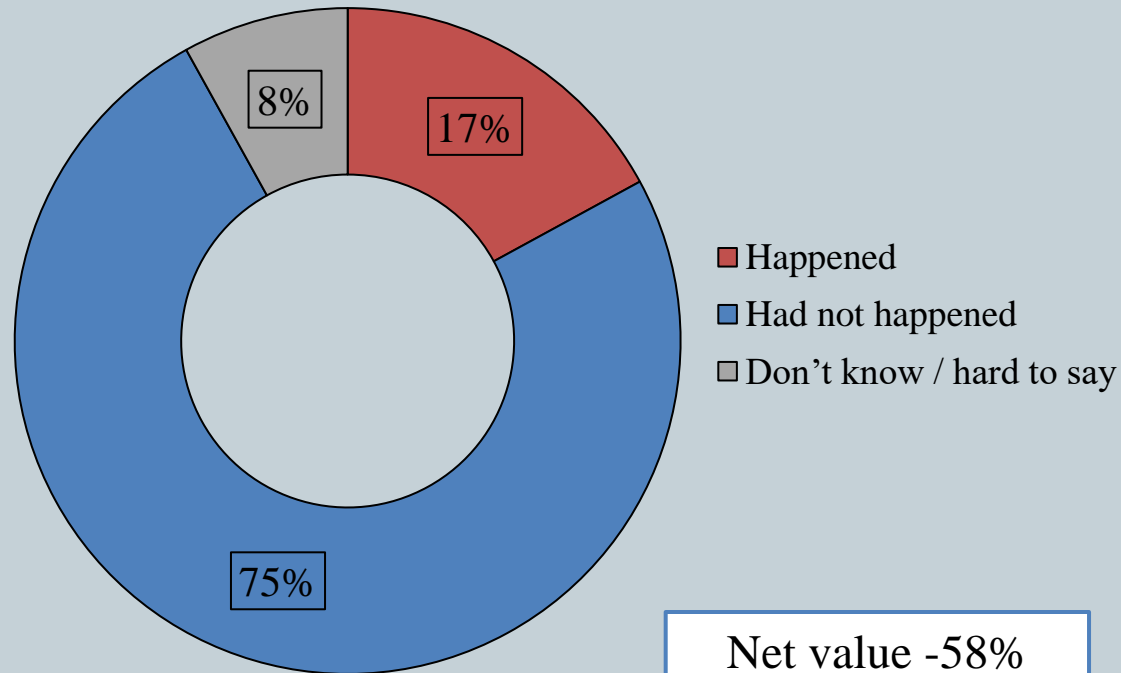
