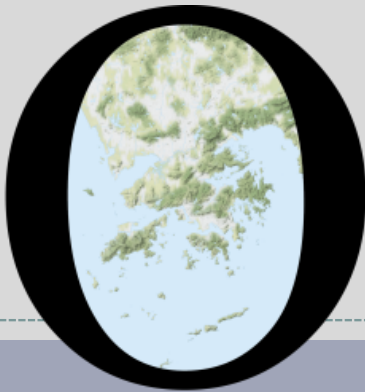

民生大聯盟發言人章彤輝博士指出，「現時中小型食肆因受惠於消費券而在生意上略有好轉。不過，大型食肆則因面對的客戶群偏向遊客及主要做婚宴團餐的生意而不見受惠。雖然市面消費有所回復，但節慶氣氛就較為冷清，應該一兩星期後才會變好。」

**Dr Tung-fai Cheung, Spokesman of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood, observed, “Small and medium-sized restaurants are now benefiting from the consumption voucher and their business has improved slightly. However, large restaurants are not benefiting from that as their clientele are mainly tourists and catering for wedding parties. Although the market has recovered a bit, the festive mood is not too good and should only improve in a week or two.”**

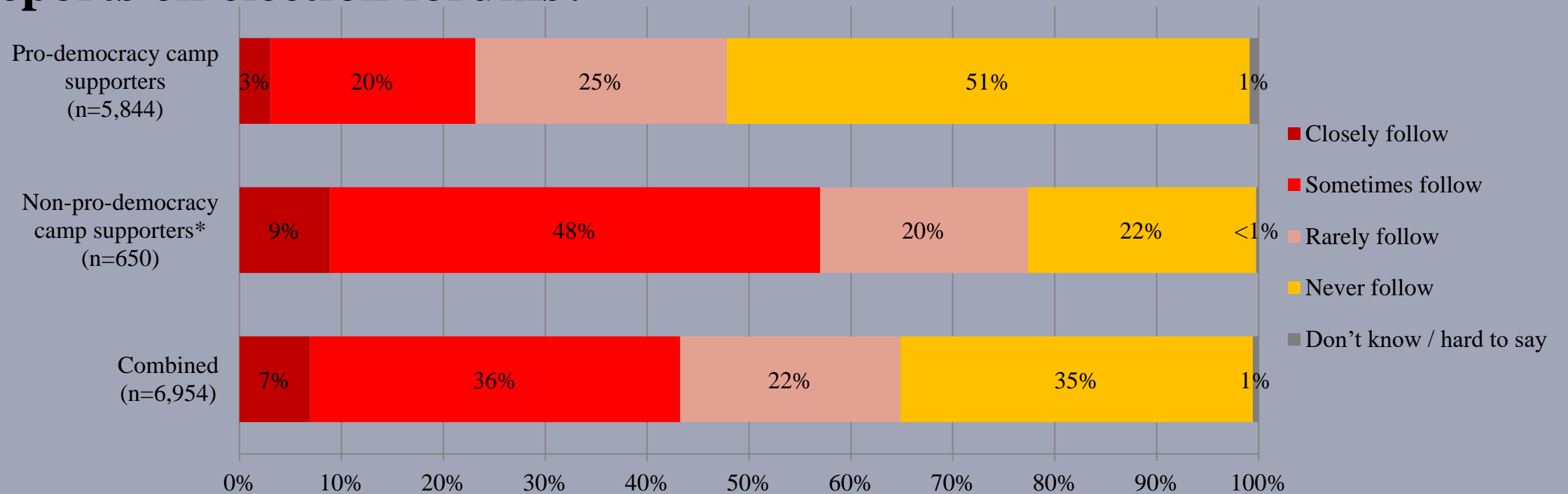

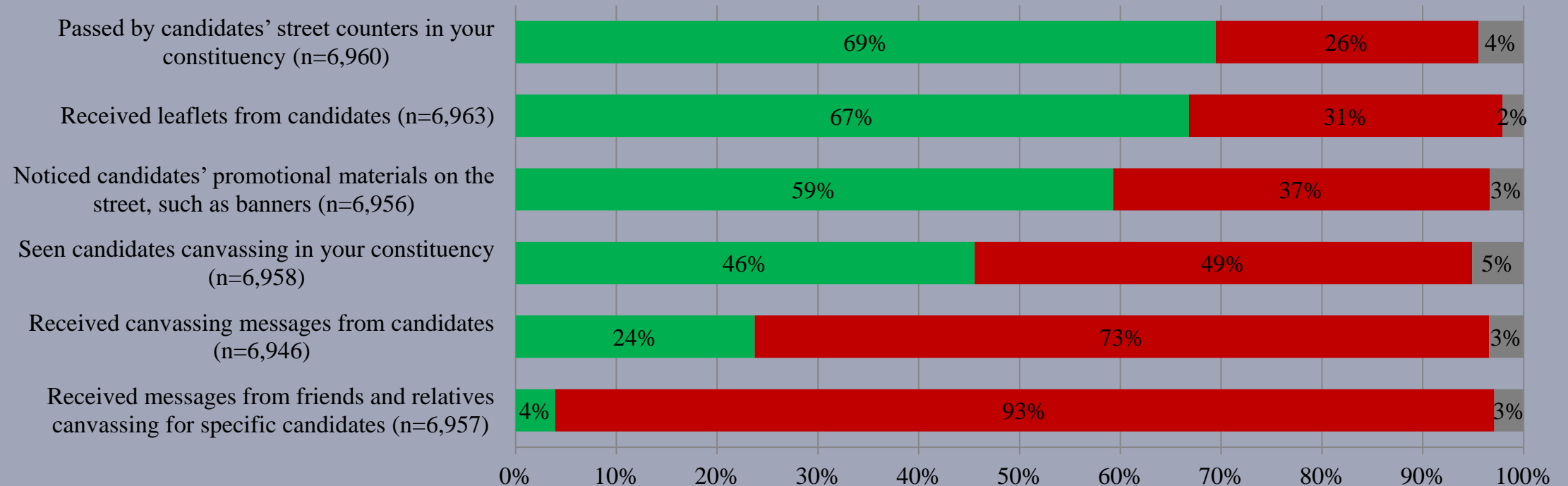

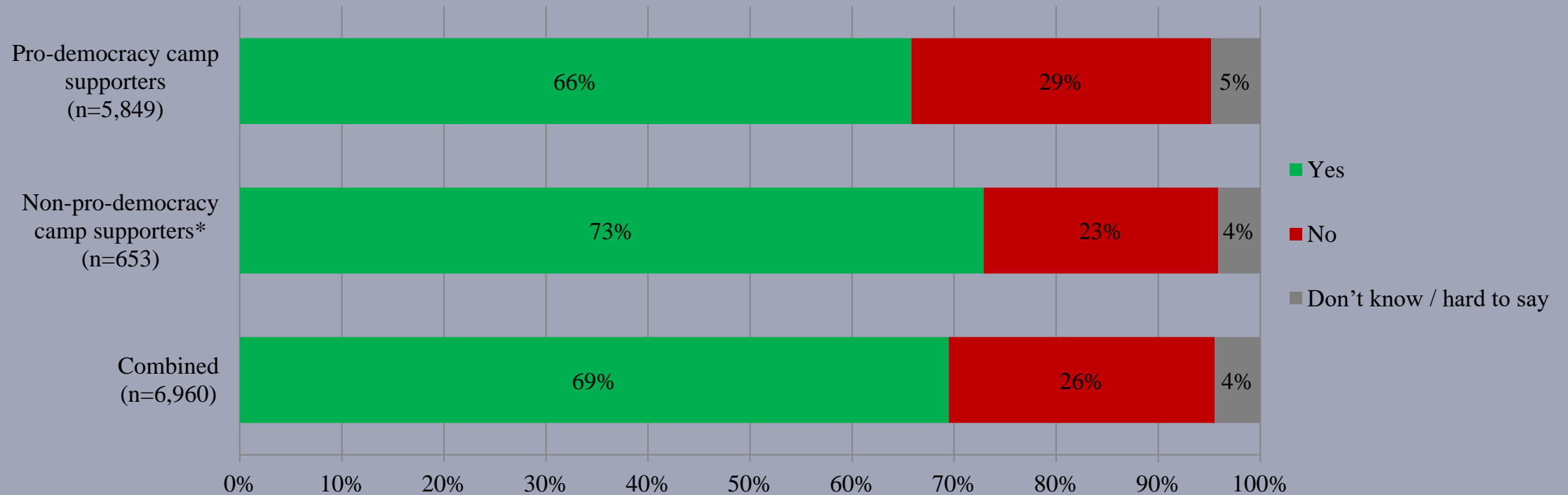

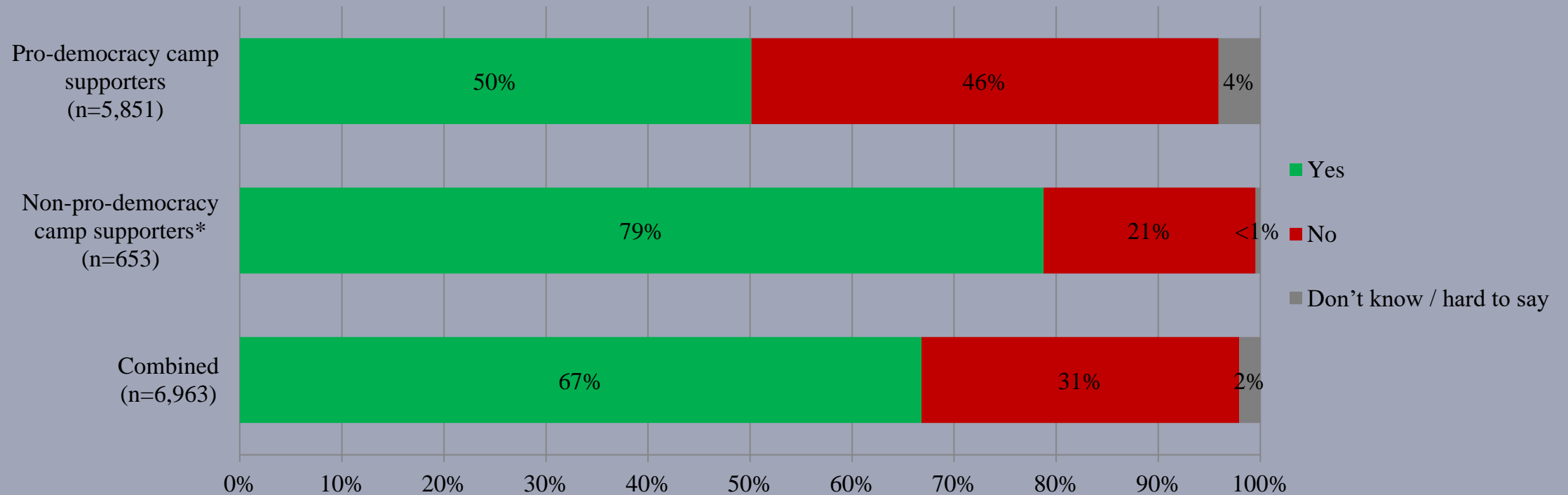

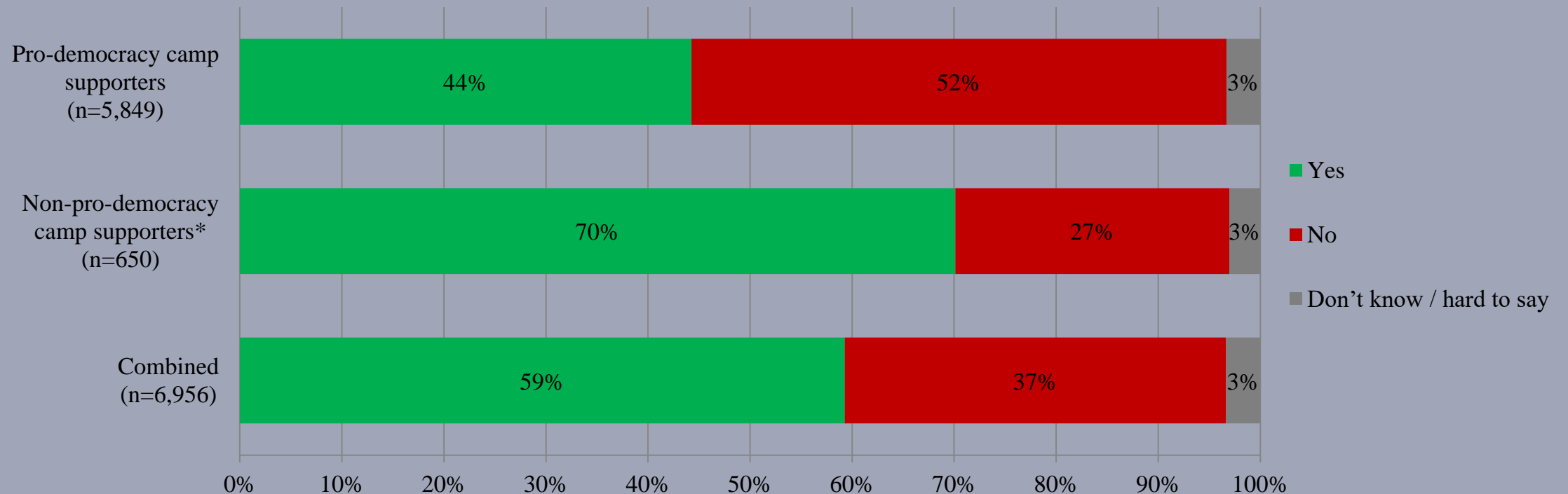

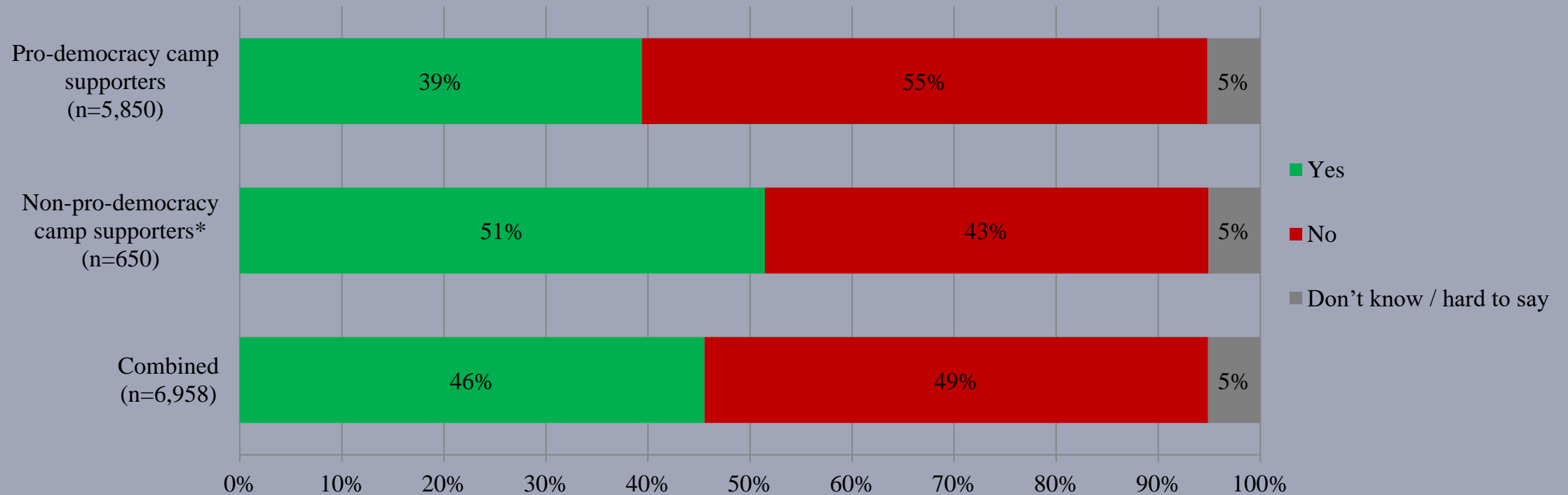

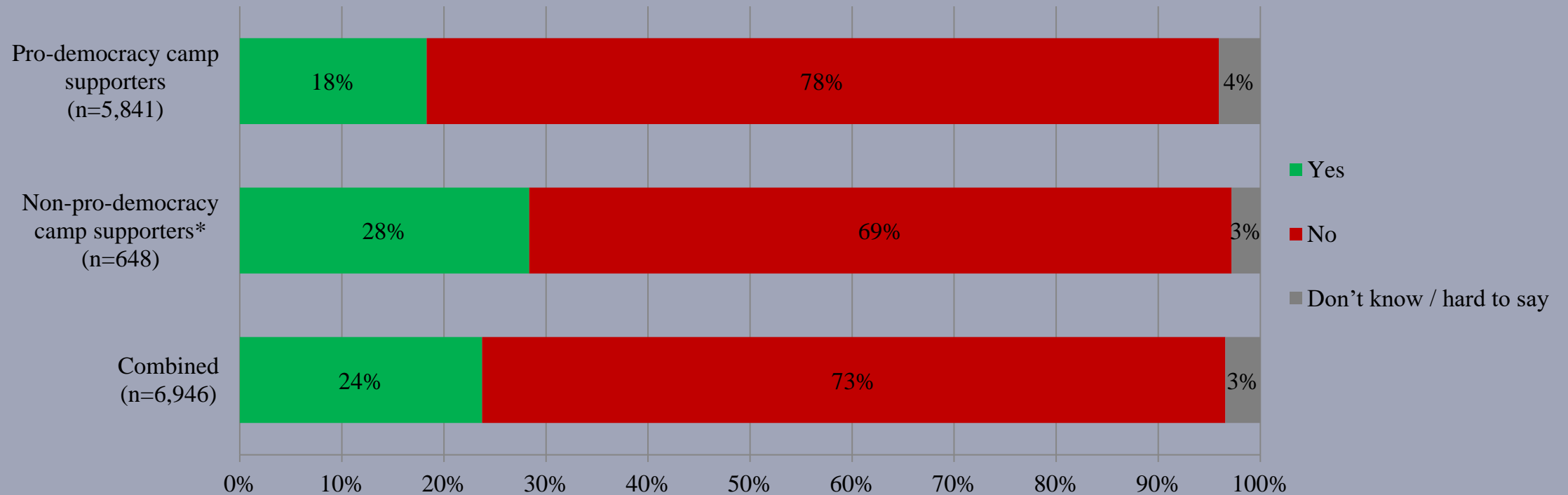

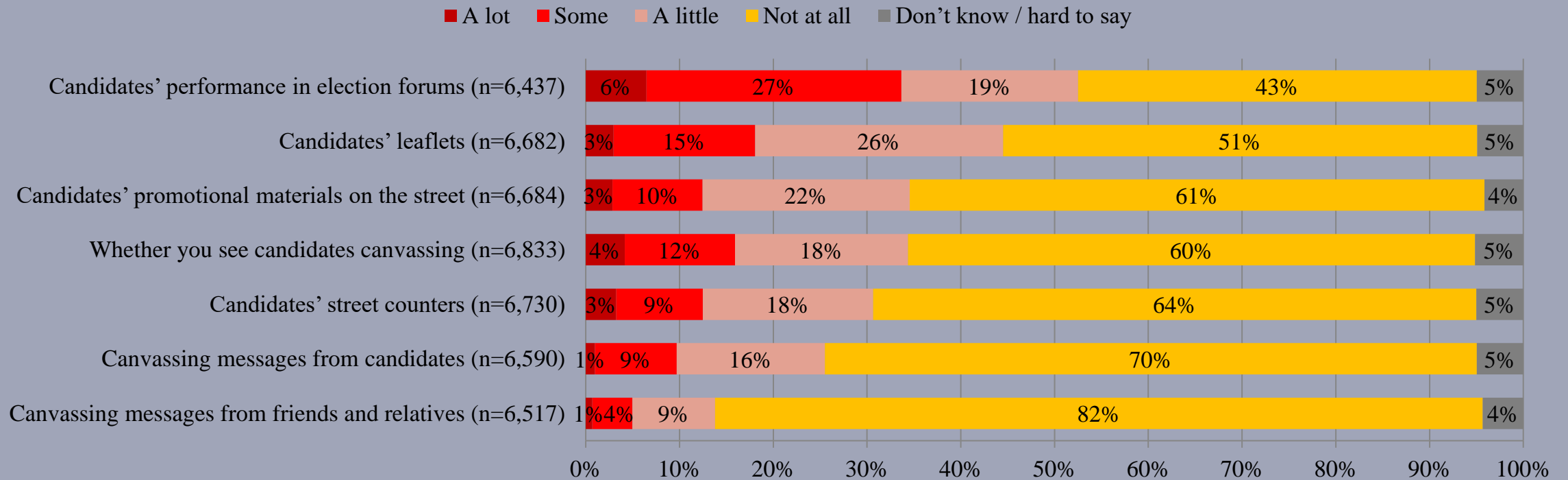

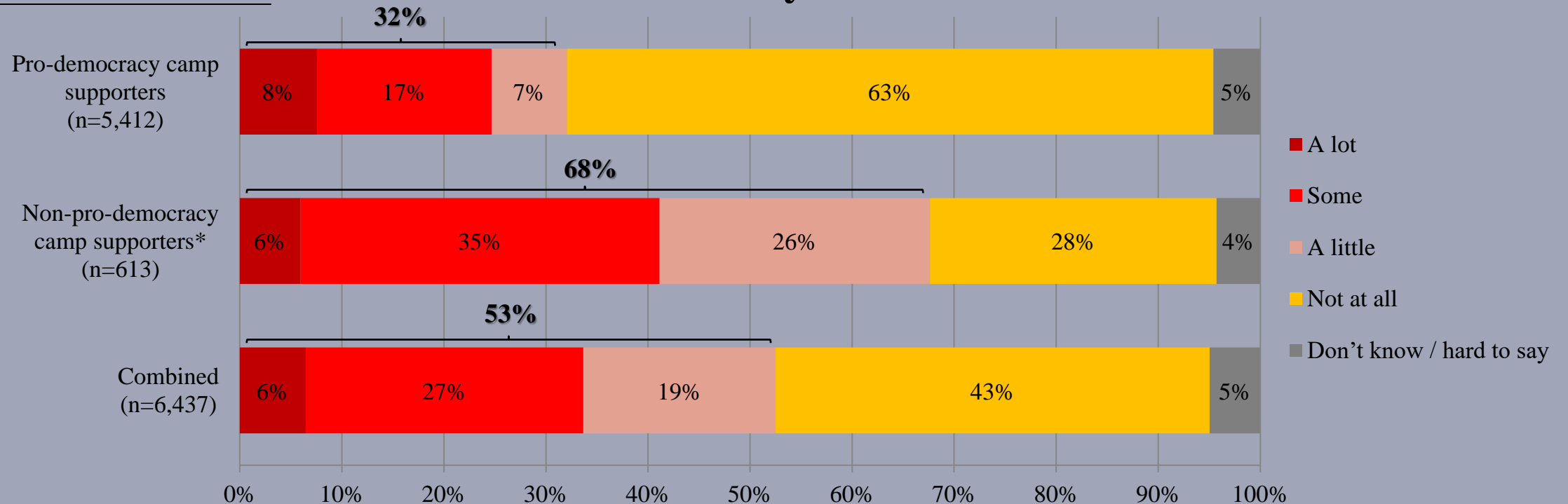

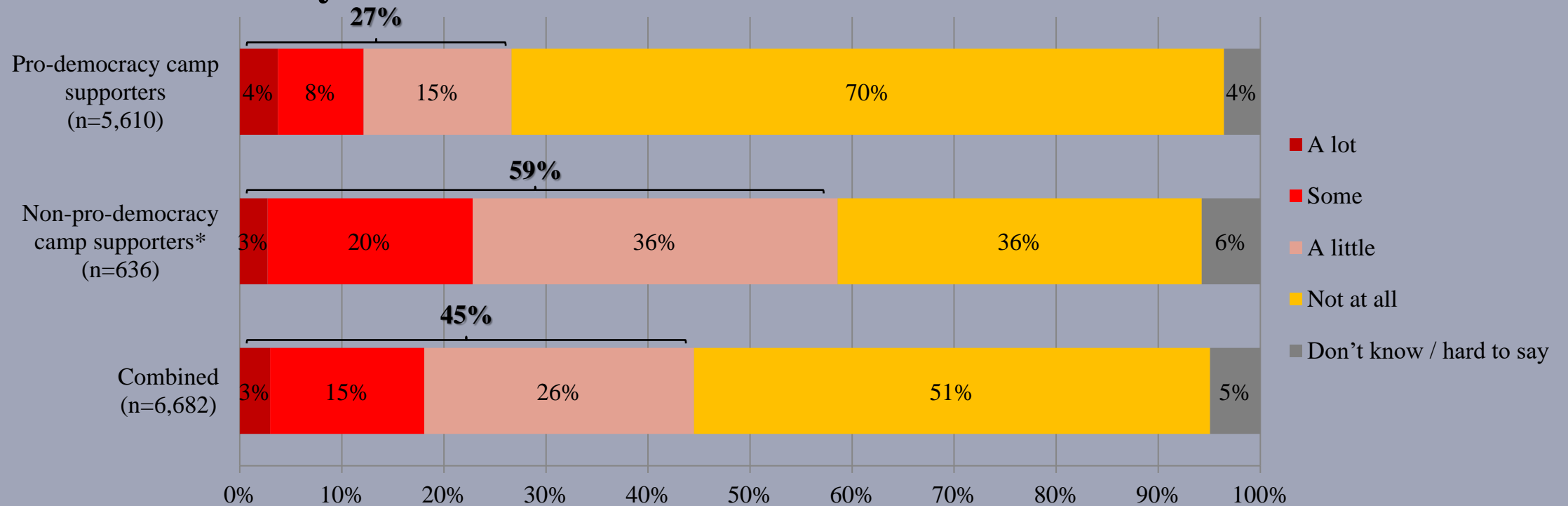

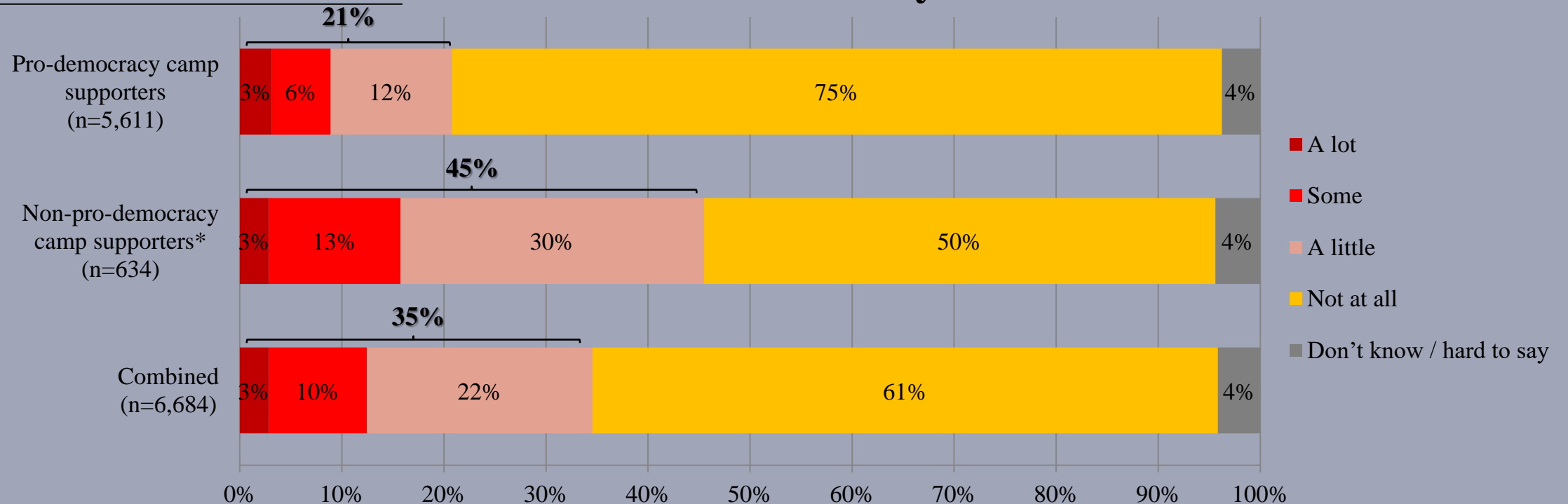

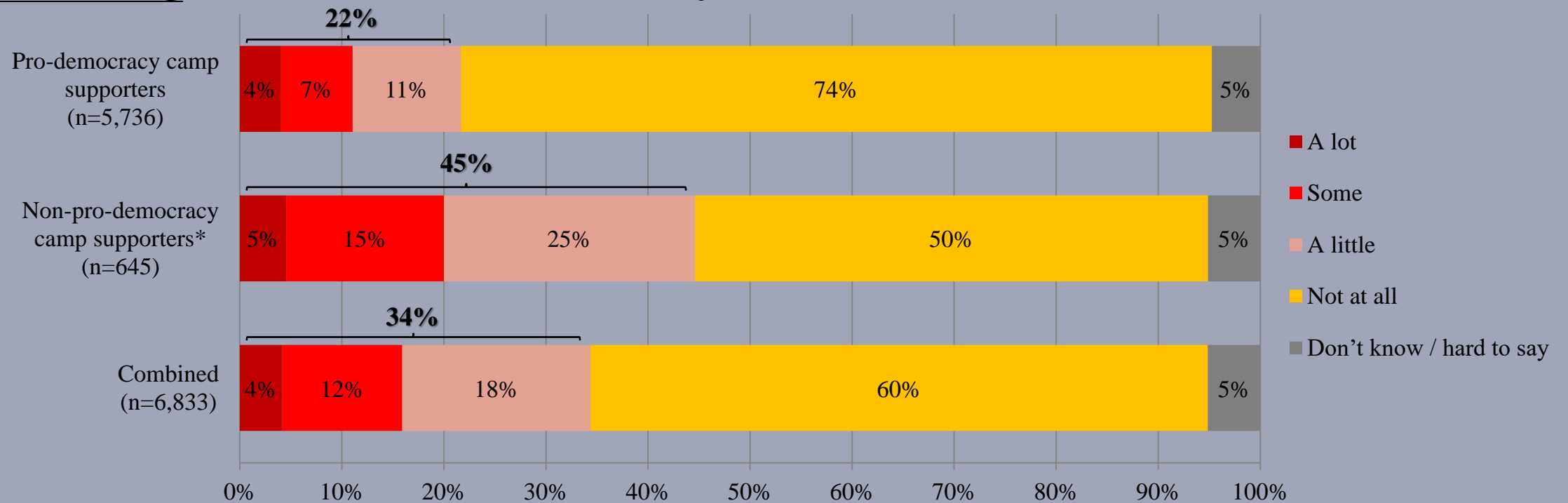

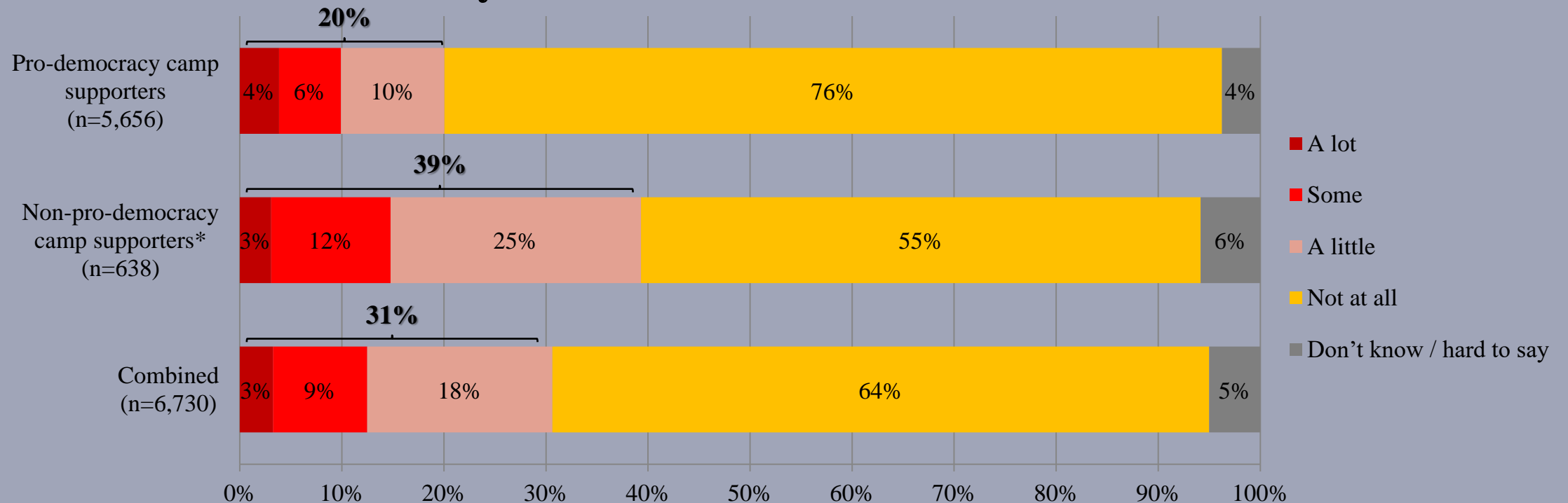

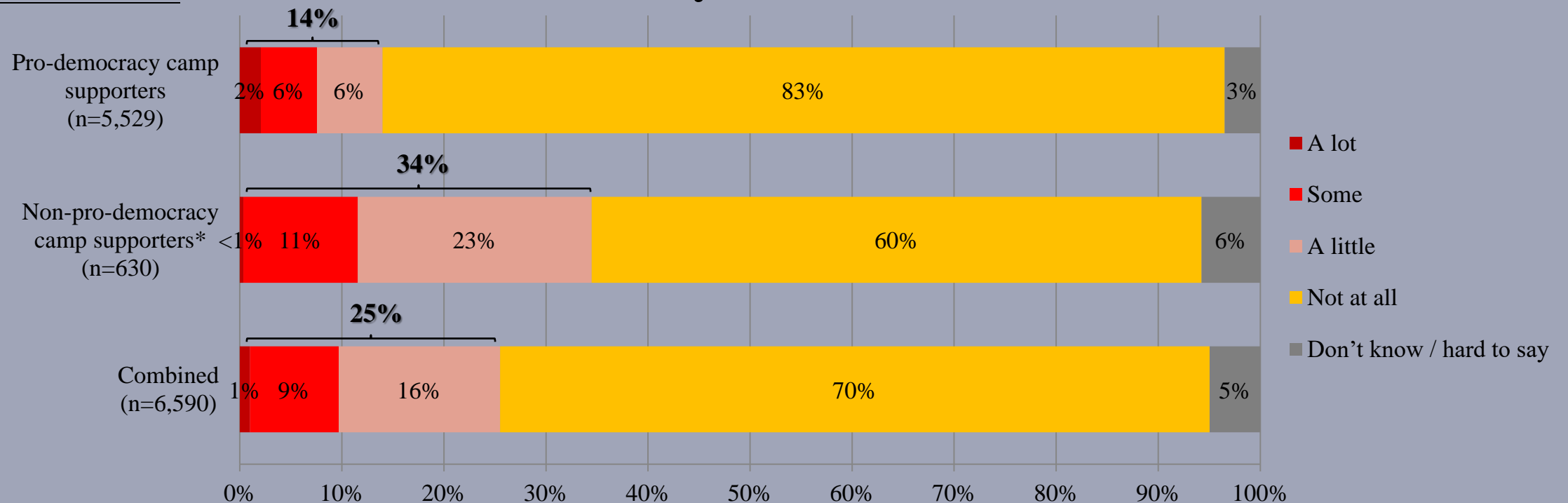

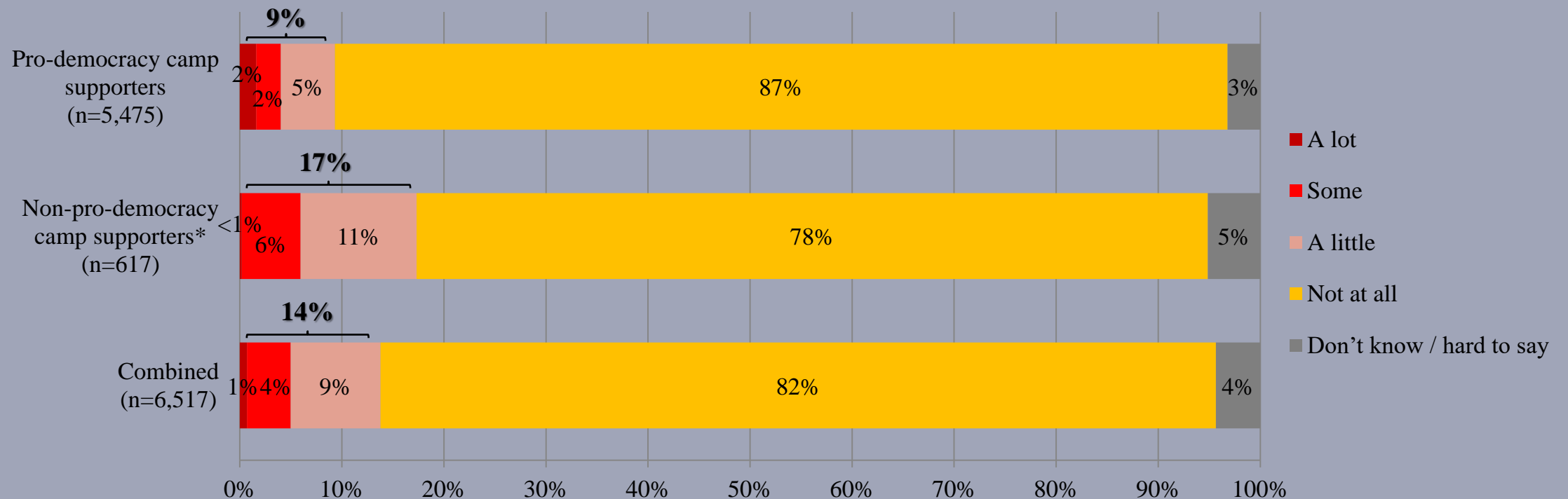

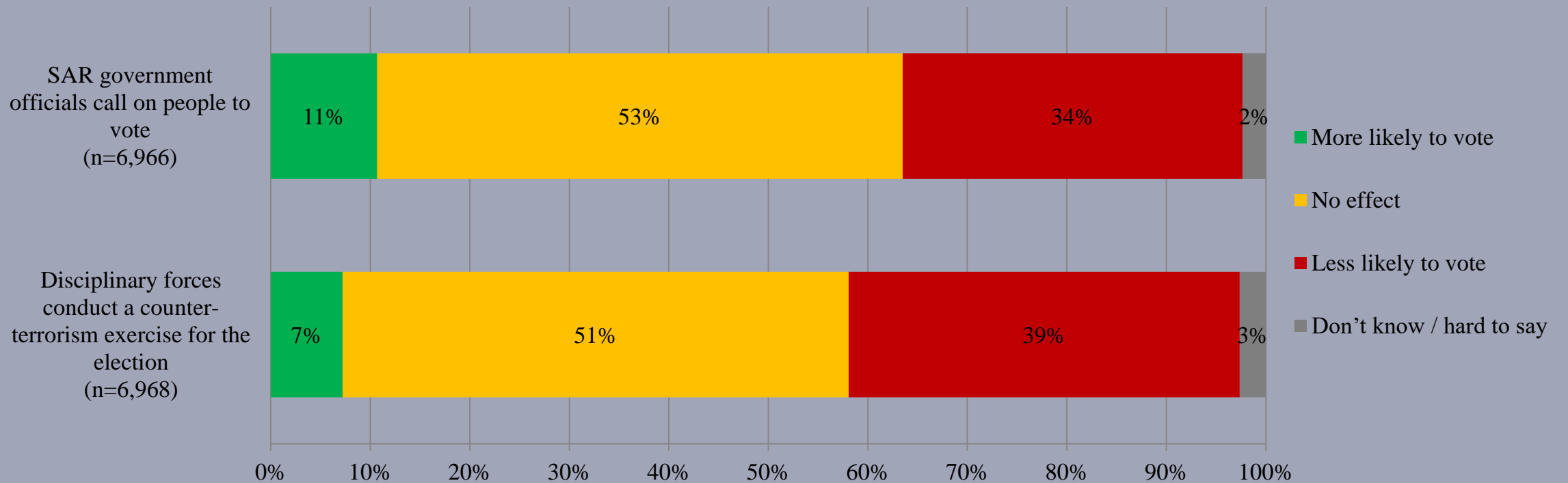

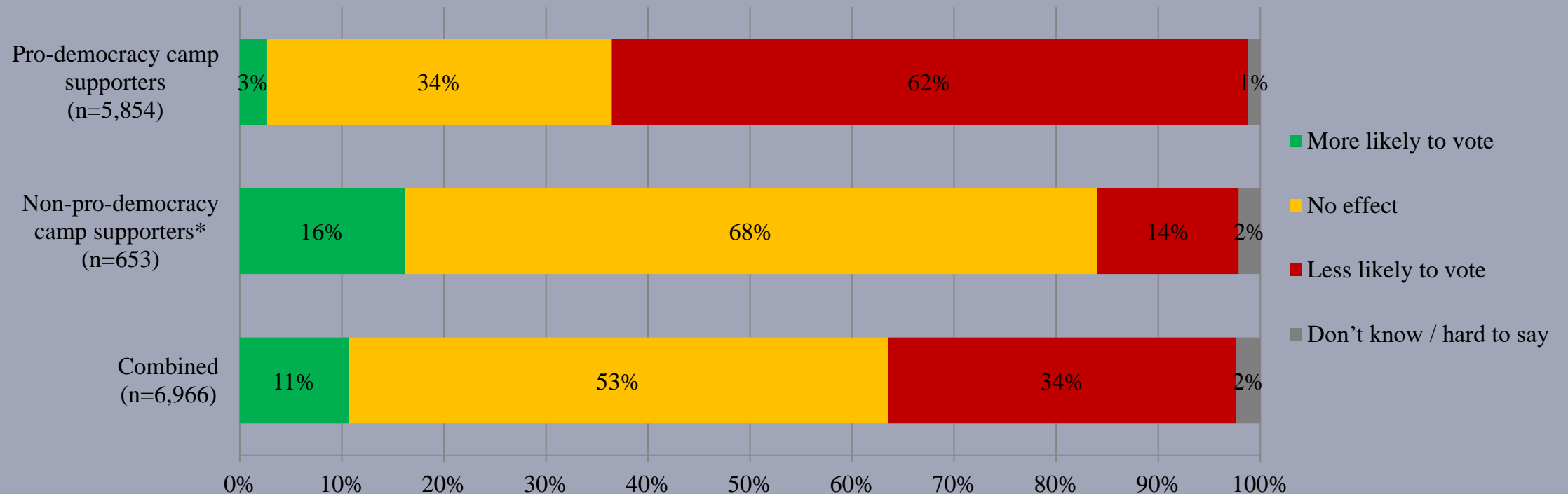

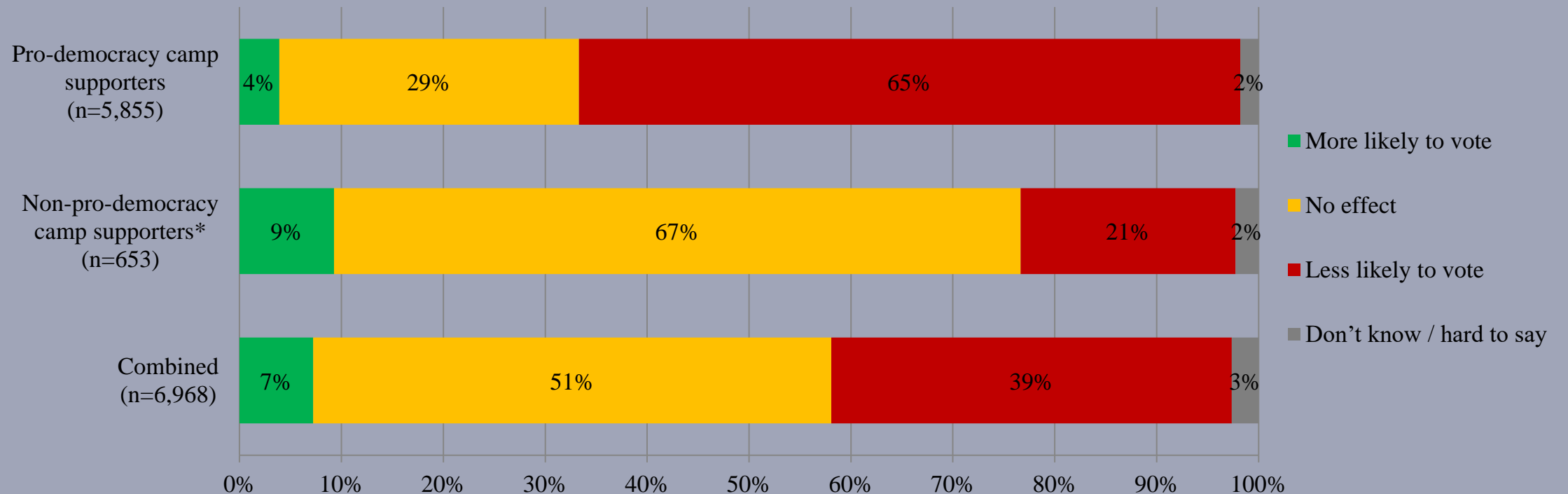
