

獨立評論人潘麒智指出:「特區政府本來計劃12月10日與國內『通關』但因為全球正爆發 Omicron變種病毒個案,令計劃暫時擱置。為有效防範變種病毒,監控疫情,除繼續谷針,檢視市民接種第三針疫苗的可行性外,更將全球幾十個出現Omicron變種病毒個案國家都列為較高風險地區,變相令香港與全球隔絕。疫情與流感已經成為地球風土病,與病毒共存,根本是唯一出路,本人再一次建議港府早着先機,勿再猶豫。」

Independent commentator KC Poon observed, "The government had originally planned to launch the quarantine-free border resumption on December 10, but the plan was put on hold due to the global outbreak of Omicron virus. In order to effectively prevent the mutated virus and monitor the epidemic, the government has continued to review the feasibility of administering a third dose of the vaccine to the public, and has also classified dozens of countries around the world with Omicron mutated virus cases as high-risk areas, effectively isolating Hong Kong from the rest of the world. The epidemic and influenza have become a global endemic, and living with the virus is the only way out. Once again, I suggest that the Hong Kong Government should not hesitate to act promptly."







• Question: Do you know which of the 10 geographic constituencies you belong to for the coming Legislative Council election?












• Question: Do the following affect your likelihood to vote?


 Question: Do you base your decision mainly on candidate's personal background or political party? #
