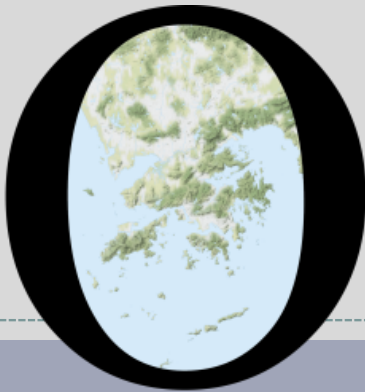
### Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

復興經濟民生大聯盟成員任偉豪指出：「林鄭特首已上京述職回來，但依然未能為港成功爭取通關。原因可能在於中央認為並沒有必要與香港通關，加上西安疫症再度大爆發以及要應付冬奧此頭等國家大事，如與港通關只會令國家徒添變數。最想通關的，可能是急於開展施政報告中的大灣區大計的林鄭特首。」

**Yam Wai Ho, member of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood observed, “Chief Executive Carrie Lam has gone to Beijing to report her work, but she still failed to obtain border resumption for Hong Kong. The reason may be that China government believes that there is no need to resume the border crossing with Hong Kong, coupled with the recurrence of the Xi’an epidemic and the need to cope with the top national event of the Winter Olympics, border resumption with Hong Kong will only add variables to the country. The person who most wants to resume border may be Chief Executive Carrie Lam, who is eager to carry out the plan for the Greater Bay Area in the Policy Address.”**

- Date of survey: 9-14/12/2021
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,017 (including 505 landline and 512 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 58.0%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4%, that of net values not more than +/-7% and that of ratings not more than +/-0.1 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2020”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2020 Edition)”.

## ● Appraisal of HK's development in the year past

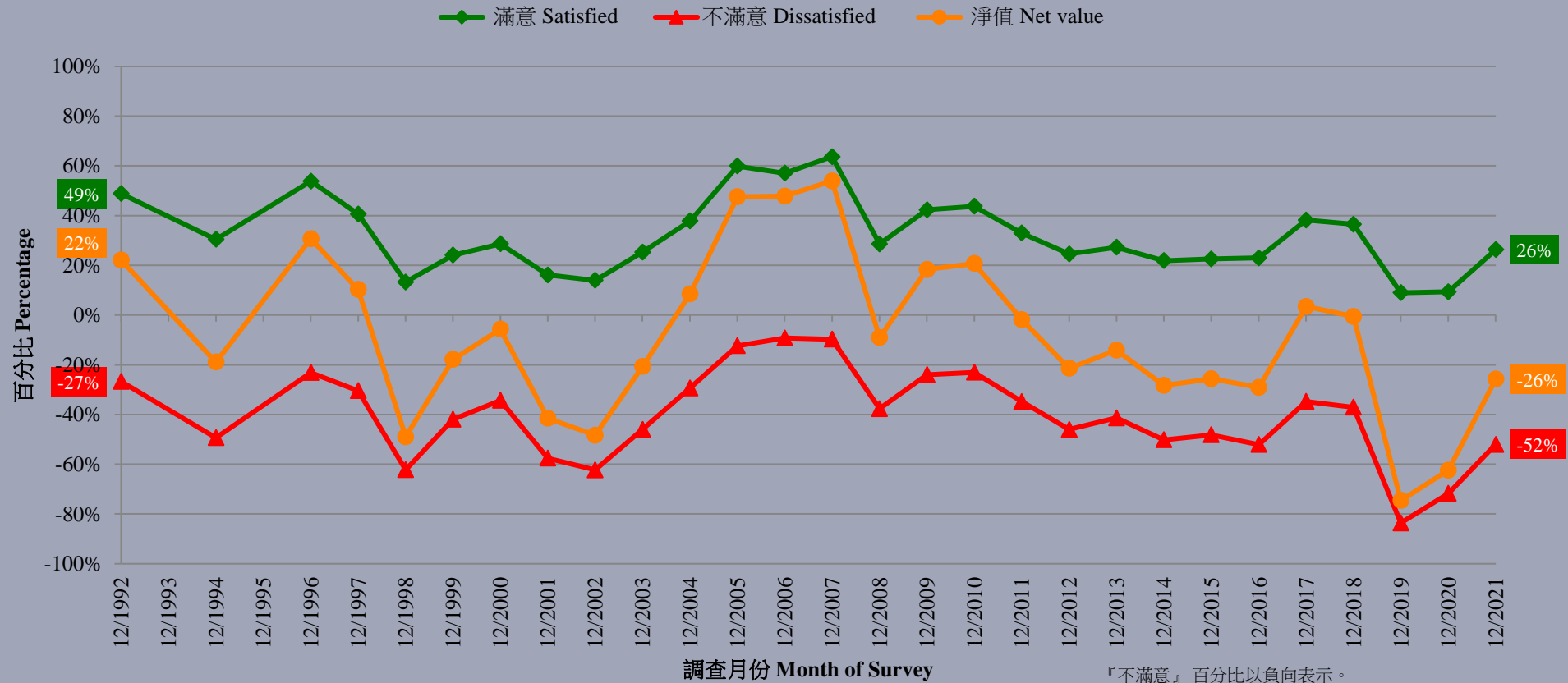
	18-22/12/2020	9-14/12/2021	Change	Record
Satisfaction rate	9%	26%	▲17% *	Record high since Dec. 2018
Dissatisfaction rate	72%	52%	▼20% *	Record low since Dec. 2018
Net satisfaction rate	-62%	-26%	▲37% *	Record high since Dec. 2018
Mean value	1.9	2.5	▲0.6 *	Record high since Dec. 2018

- Our annual year-end survey shows that 26% were satisfied with Hong Kong's development in the year past, 52% were dissatisfied, giving a net satisfaction of negative 26 percentage points. The mean score is 2.5, meaning between "quite dissatisfied" and "half-half" in general. The situation continued to improve significantly compared to last two years.

## ● Happiness level in the year past

Happy	13%	29%	▲16% *	Record high since Dec. 2018
Unhappy	59%	40%	▼19% *	Record low since Dec. 2018
Net happiness value	-45%	-10%	▲35% *	Record high since Dec. 2018
Mean value	2.2	2.8	▲0.5 *	Record high since Dec. 2018

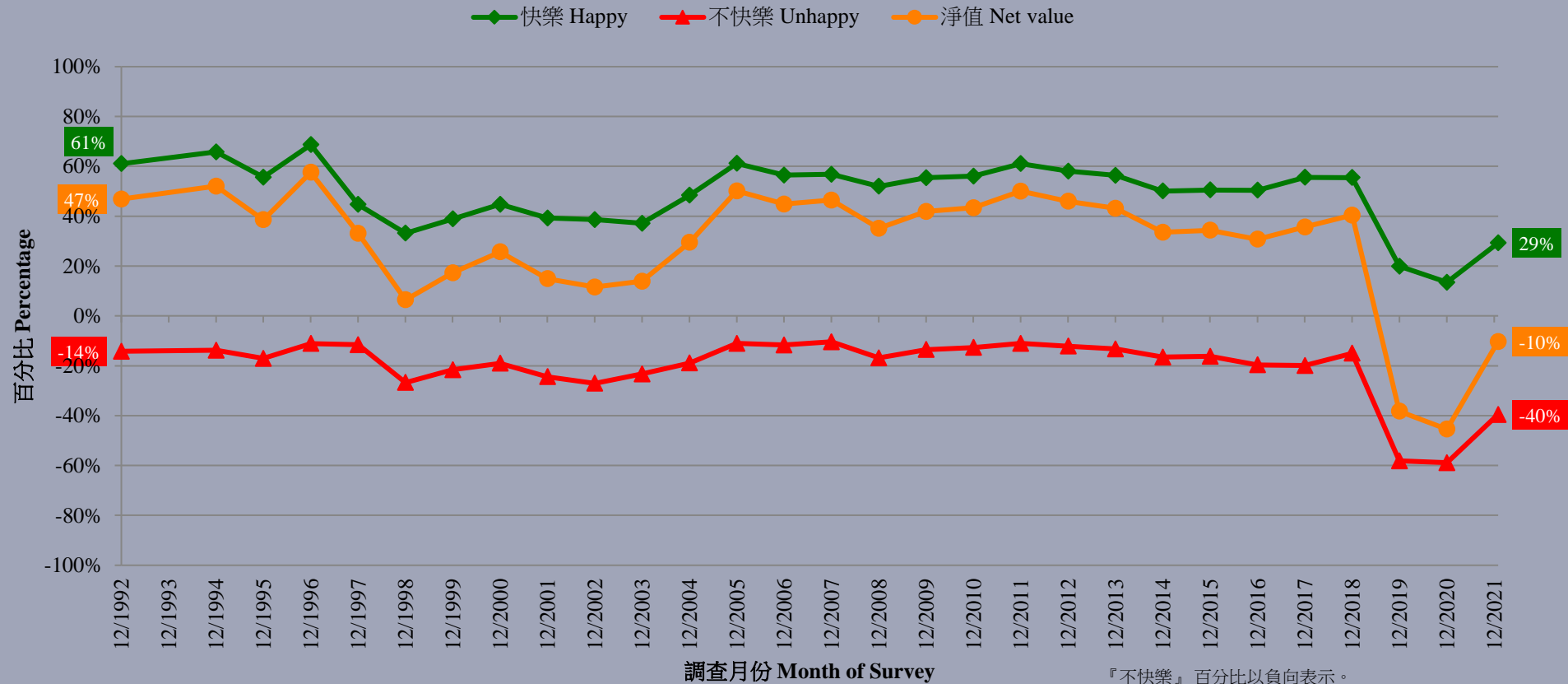
- At an individual level, 29% said they lived a happy life in the year past, 40% said they were not happy, giving a net happiness value of negative 10 percentage points. The mean score is 2.8, meaning close to “half-half” in general. The situation has also improved significantly compared to last two years.

(12/1992 - 12/2021)

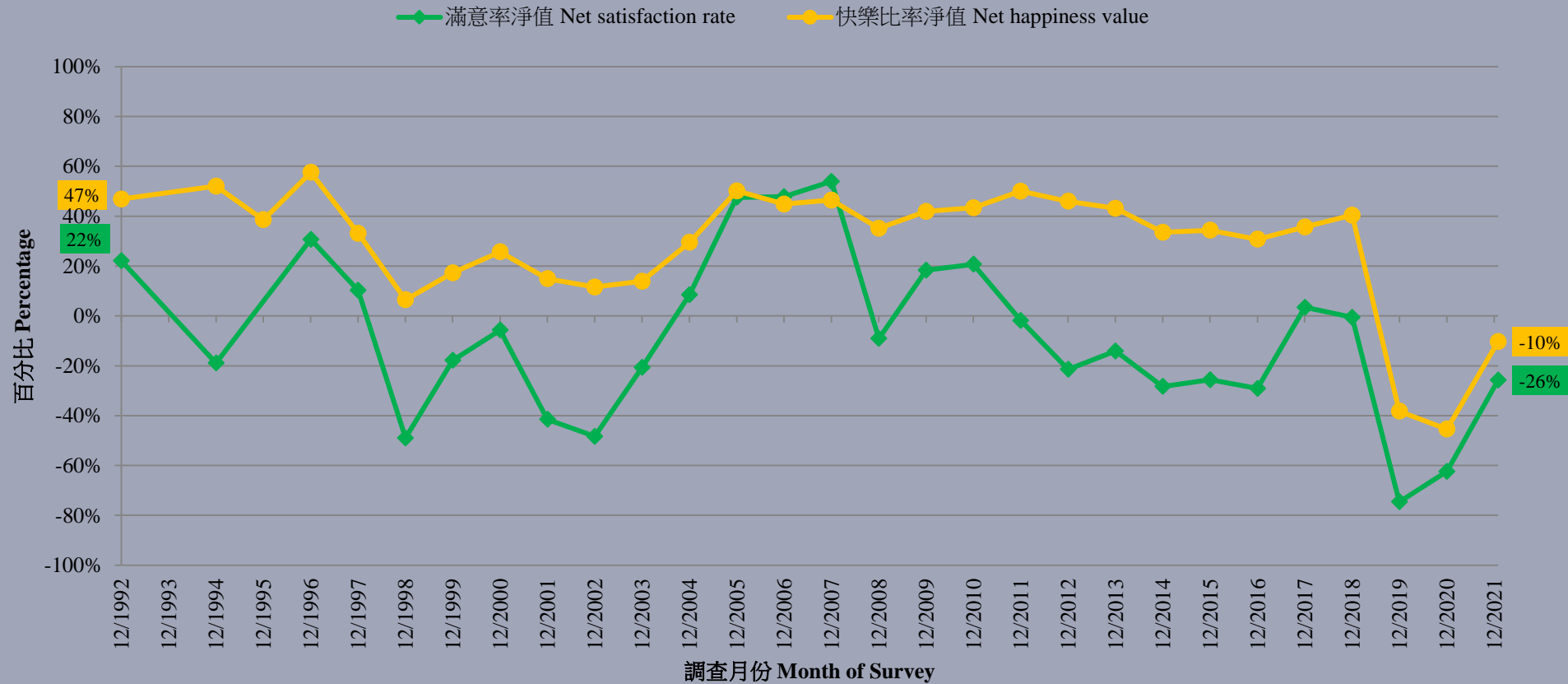

## ● Expectation of HK's development next year

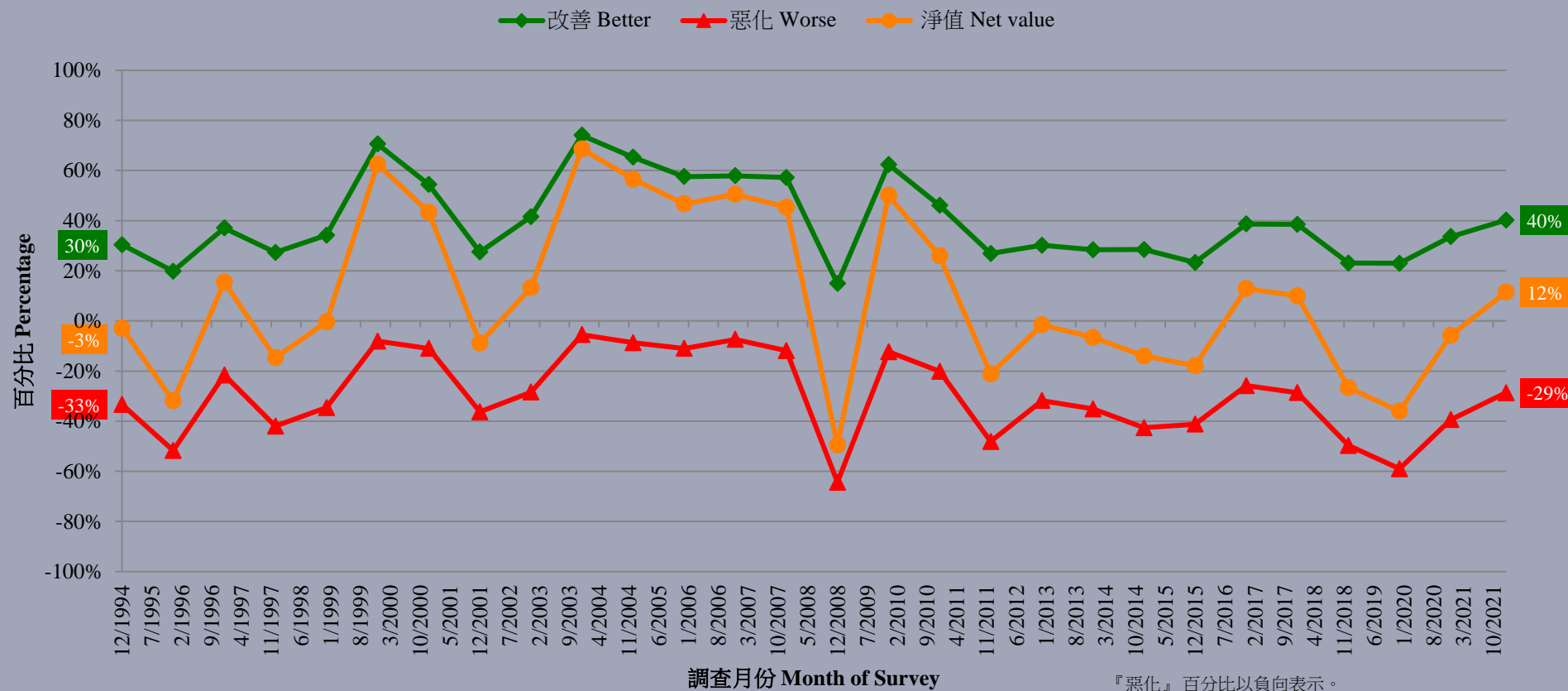

Better	34%	40%	▲7% *	Record high since Dec. 2010
Worse	39%	29%	▼11% *	Record low since Dec. 2017
Net optimism	-6%	12%	▲17% *	Record high since Dec. 2016

- Looking ahead, 40% expected Hong Kong's overall development next year would be better than last year, 29% said it would be worse, giving a net optimism of positive 12 percentage points, which has also increased significantly from last year and registered a record high since 2016.

## • Expectation of personal development next year

Better	31%	42%	▲11% *	Record <b>high</b> since Dec. 2016
Worse	25%	15%	▼9% *	Record <b>low</b> since Dec. 2017
Net optimism	6%	26%	▲20% *	Record <b>high</b> since Dec. 2016

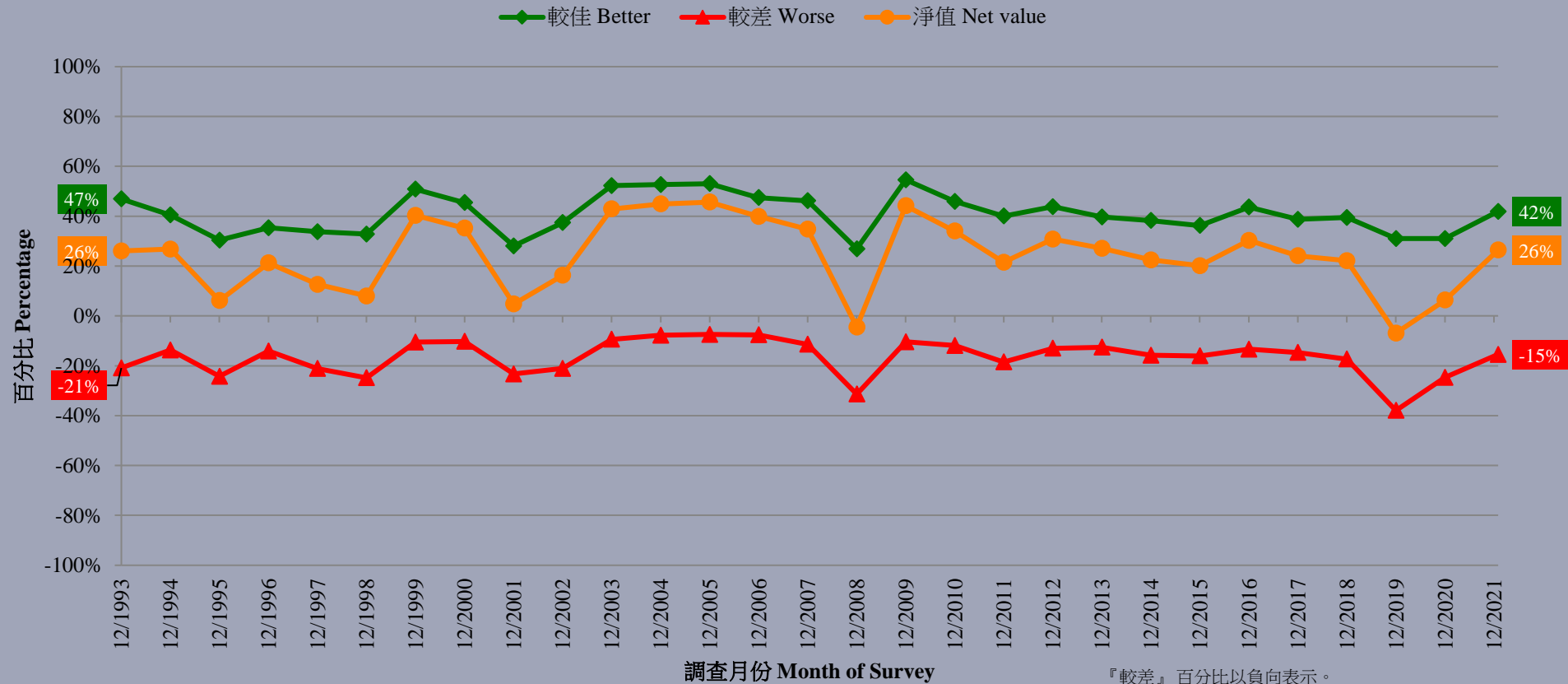
- As for the coming year, 42% believed their personal development would become better, 15% thought they would be getting worse, giving a net optimism of positive 26 percentage points, which has also increased significantly from last year and registered a new record **high** since 2016.

(12/1993 - 12/2021)



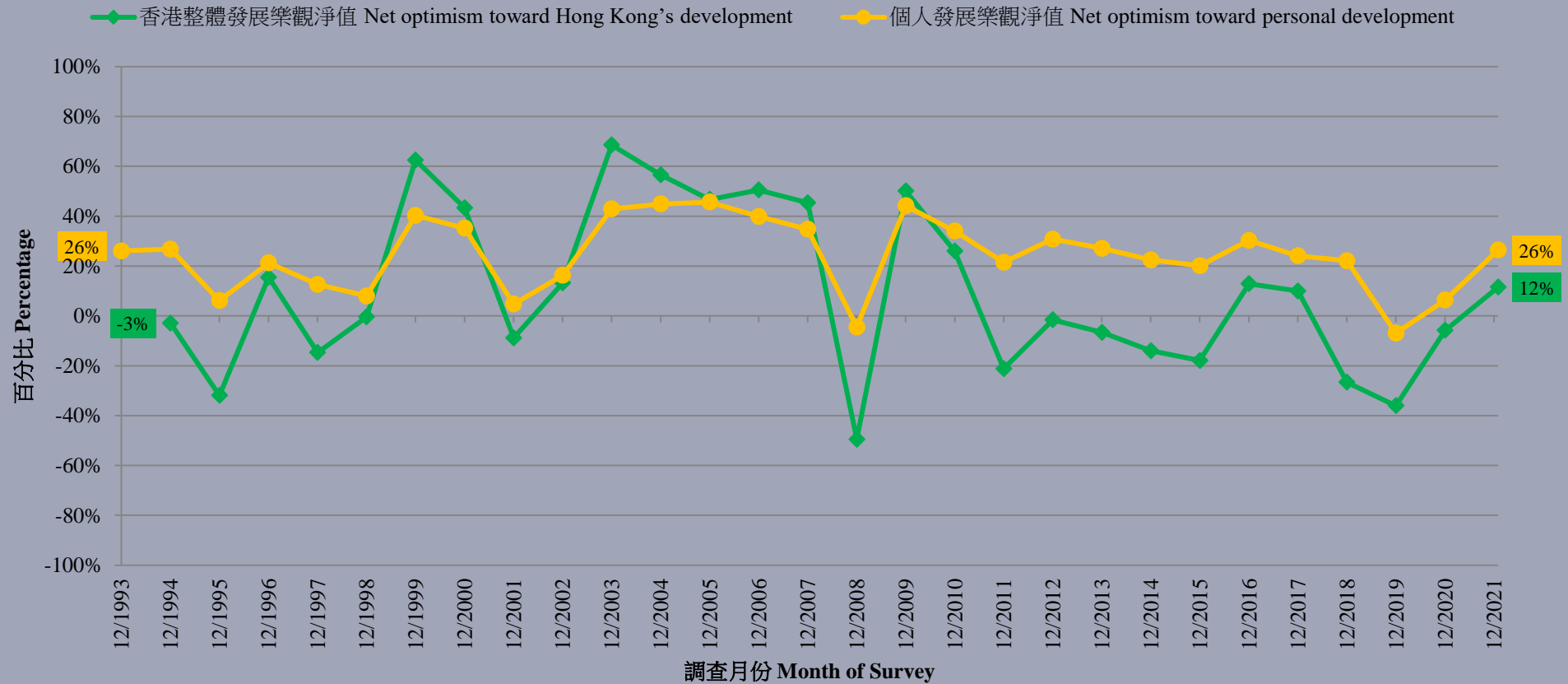

## • New Year wishes

	18-22/12/2020	9-14/12/2021	Change	Record
Society-related	49%	40%	▼9% *	Record <b>low</b> since Dec. 2018
Personal matters	22%	22%	--	--
World peace-related	7%	6%	▼1%	Record <b>low</b> since Dec. 1998
No special wish	10%	18%	▲8% *	All-time record <b>high</b> since Dec. 1992

- As for people's New Year wishes, society-related ones continued to drop to 40%, while 22% were wishes related to personal matters. Only 6% were world peace-related, registering a record **low** since 1998. Meanwhile, as many as 18% said they did not have New Year wishes, registering a new **high** since the survey series began in 1992.
