- Compared to seven months ago, the ratings of FTU and DAB have increased significantly, which have registered **record high** since October 2018. Meanwhile, the ratings of Labour Party, Liberal Party, New People's Party and BPA have also registered **record high** since April 2019. But that of BPA is dropped due to its relatively low recognition rate. Although the change has not gone beyond sampling error, LSD is the only political group whose rating has decreased compared to the last survey.
