HKPORI Online Event Participation Guidelines (Updated on May 1, 2022)

- 1. Please join the Zoom meeting before the event starts by clicking on this weblink: https://zoom.us/j/92925996764?pwd=aE5VakF5TjcyMzdJSTFDZ01ReGlaUT09 Meeting ID: 929 2599 6764; Passcode: 199935; or by scanning the QR Code on the right.
- 2. Please name your account according to your organisation, otherwise you may be refused admission.
- 3. Wait patiently for the host to admit you into the **Zoom** Meeting Room.
- 4. During the Q&A session, we suggest you first submit your question in writing to the host in the Zoom Chat Room. In case of technical problem, your question may be read out by the moderator.
- 5. The host will then give you signal when it is almost your turn to ask your question.
- 6. Please then <u>unmute your Zoom</u> session microphone to ask your question; in case technical problems creep in, the moderator will read the question for you.
- 7. No foul language or personal attack is allowed; the host or the moderator may sharp cut the conversation when this happens.
