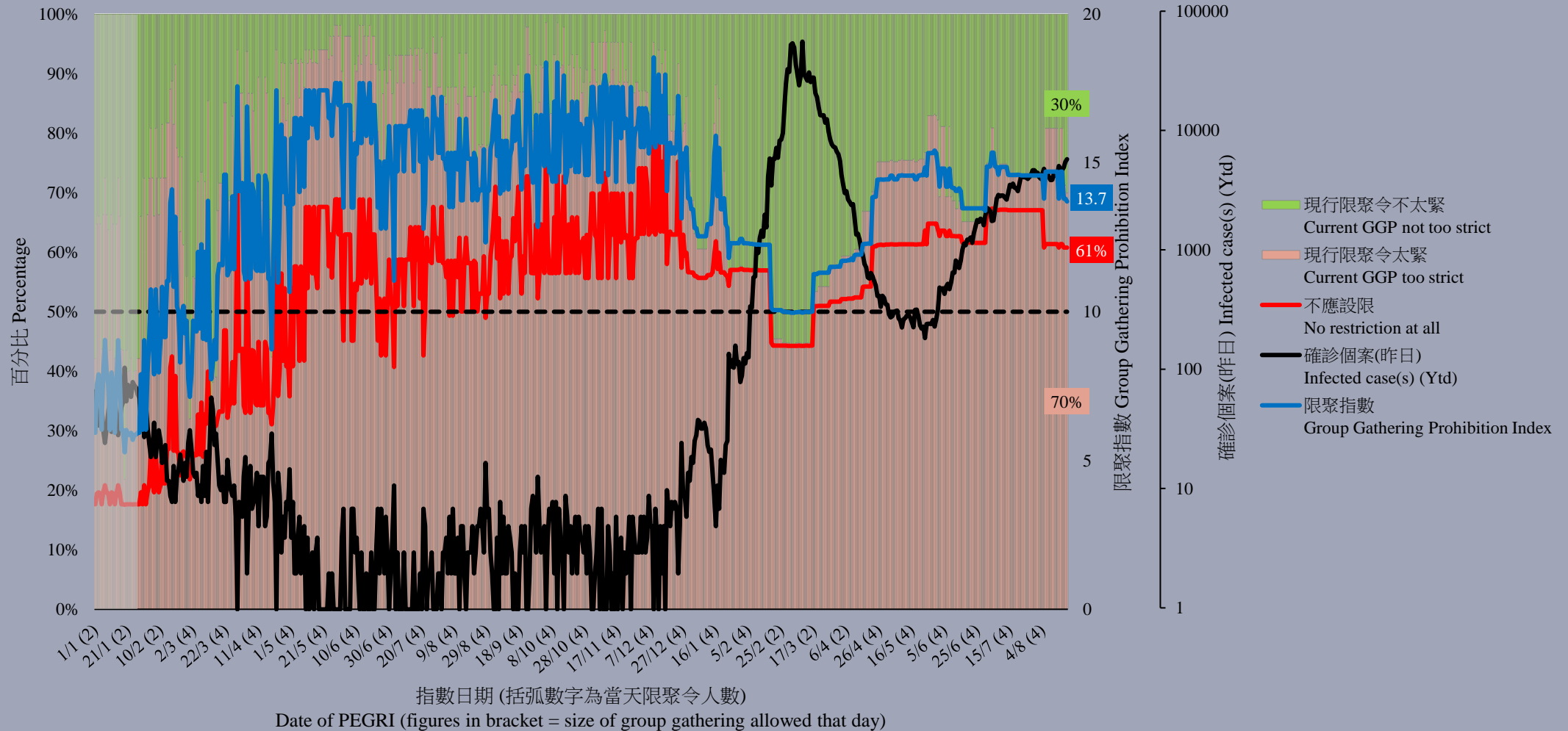

Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

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復興經濟民生大聯盟發言人章彤輝博士指出，「進入暑假，隨著不少大型活動，例如書展、美食博覽、動漫展等陸續展開，人流聚集已經常態化了。限聚指數維持在 13-14 這個數值，表示市民對政府目前限聚的力度並不支持，更多是寄望口罩和疫苗等免疫措施能提供防護。近期每天超過 5000 宗確診，看來免隔離通關短期內是不可能了。另一方面，政府調整了到港人士的隔離期，也爭取縮短了回內地的酒店隔離期，數字上大家感到好過一些，但在經濟上來講，旅遊和飲食業的困境沒有實質的改善，近來一些老字號的食肆結業，其實只是冰山一角罷了。」

Dr Tung-fai Cheung, Spokesman of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood, observed, “As we enter summer vacation, with many large-scale events such as Book Fair, Food Expo, Animation-Comic-Game Fair etc, the gathering of people has become normal. GGPI remains at 13-14, indicating that the public is not supportive of the government's current efforts in restricting gathering, and is looking more to immunization measures such as masks and vaccines to provide protection. With more than 5,000 confirmed cases per day recently, it seems that quarantine-free border resumption is not possible in the near future. On the other hand, the government has adjusted the quarantine period for people arriving to Hong Kong, and also strived to shorten the quarantine period in hotels for people returning to the mainland, so people feel better in terms of figures, but economically speaking, the plight of the tourism and catering industries has not improved in real terms, and the recent closure of some old restaurants is actually just the tip of the iceberg.”

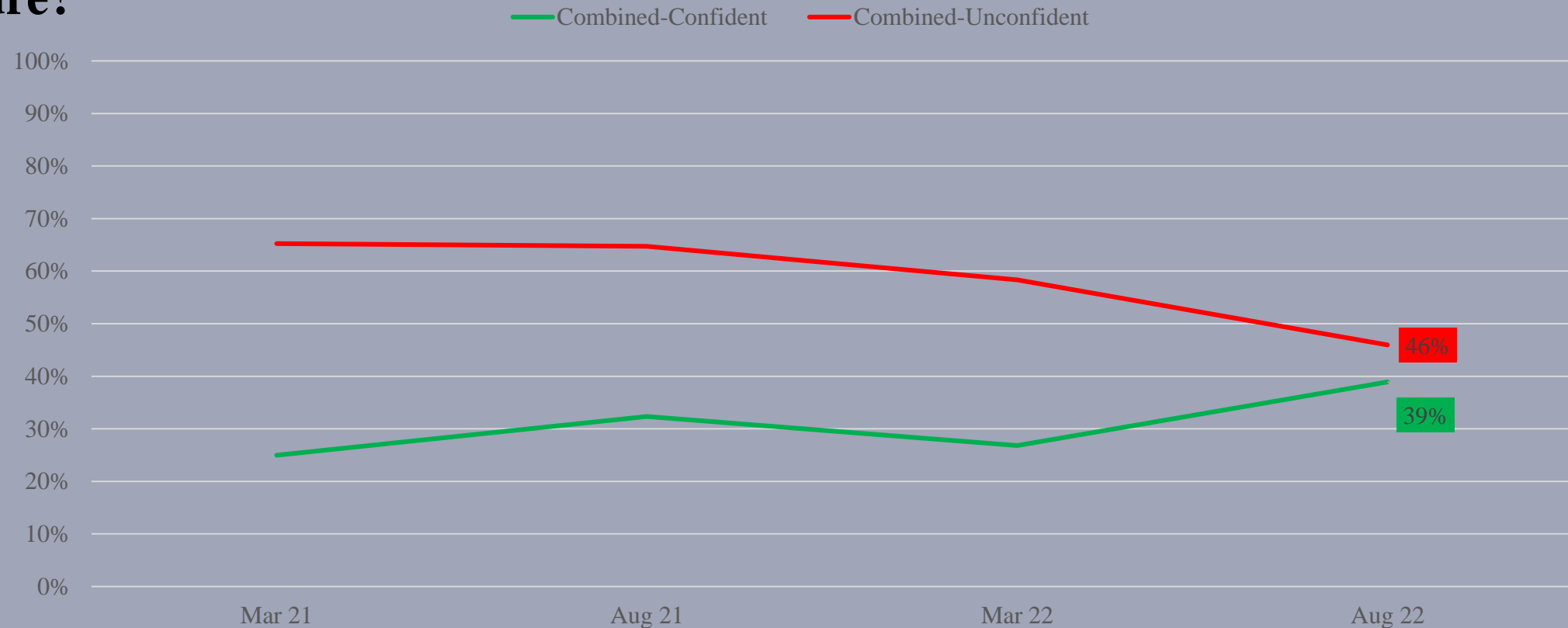

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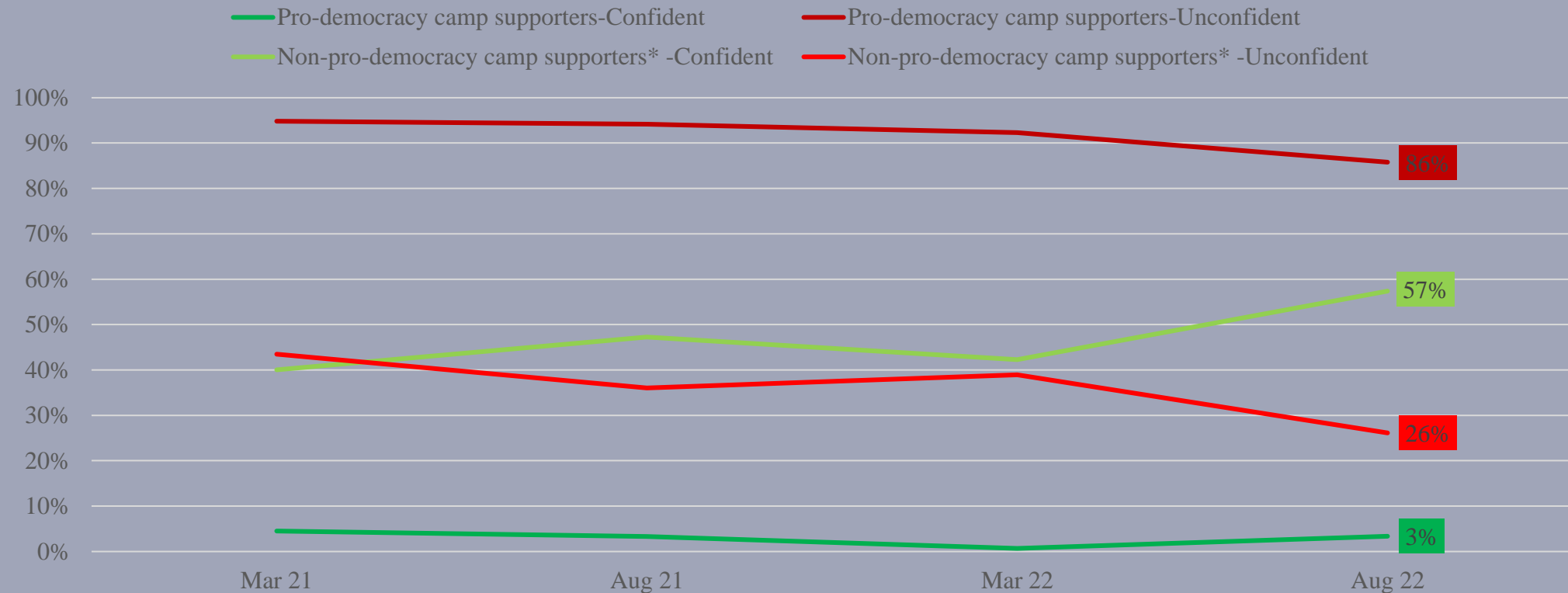

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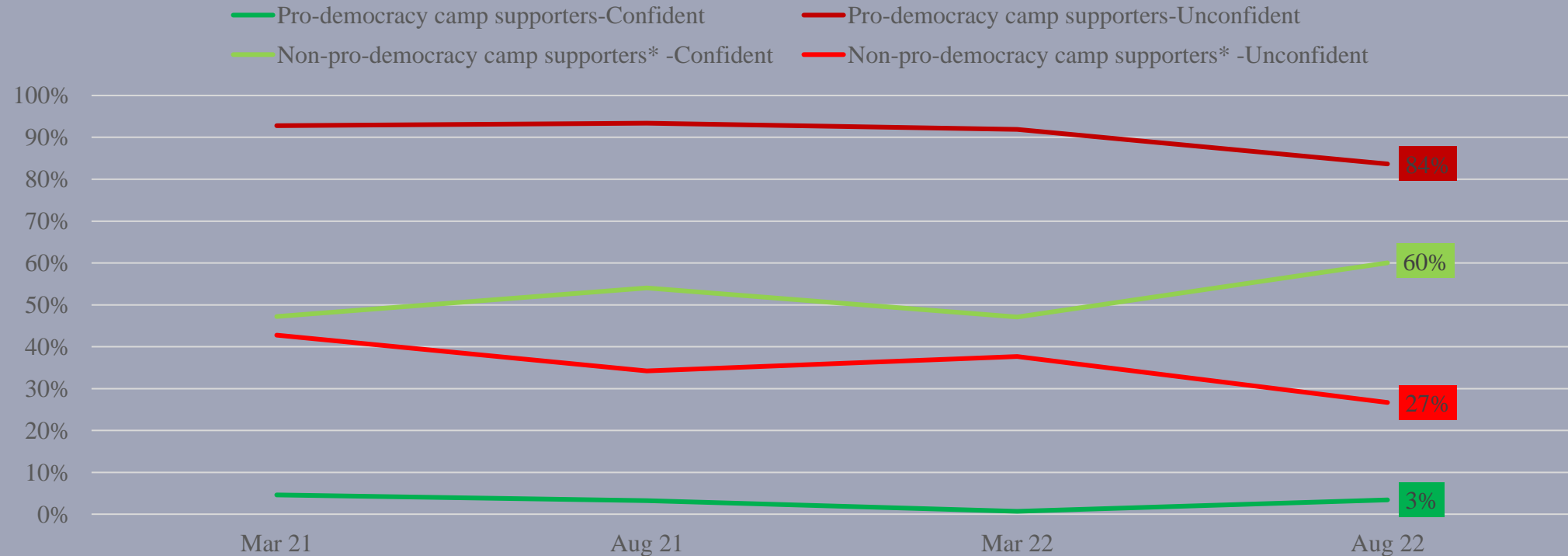

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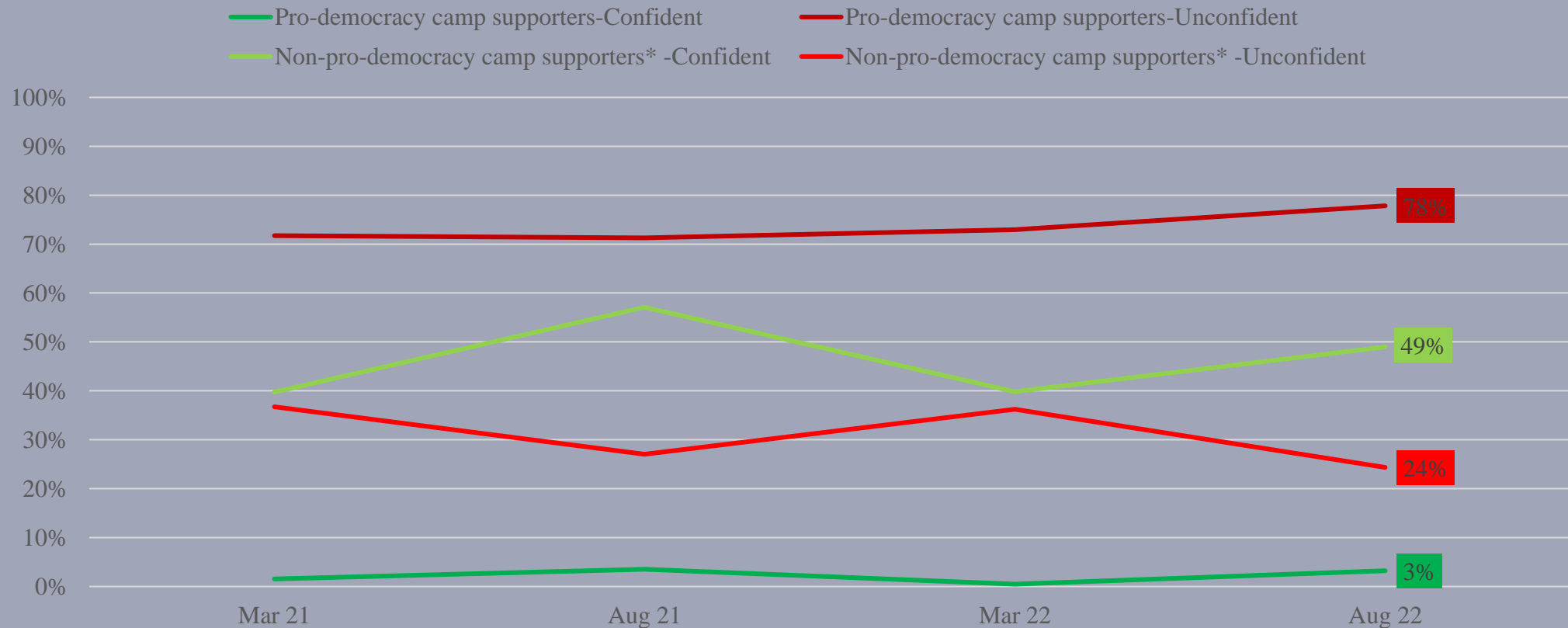

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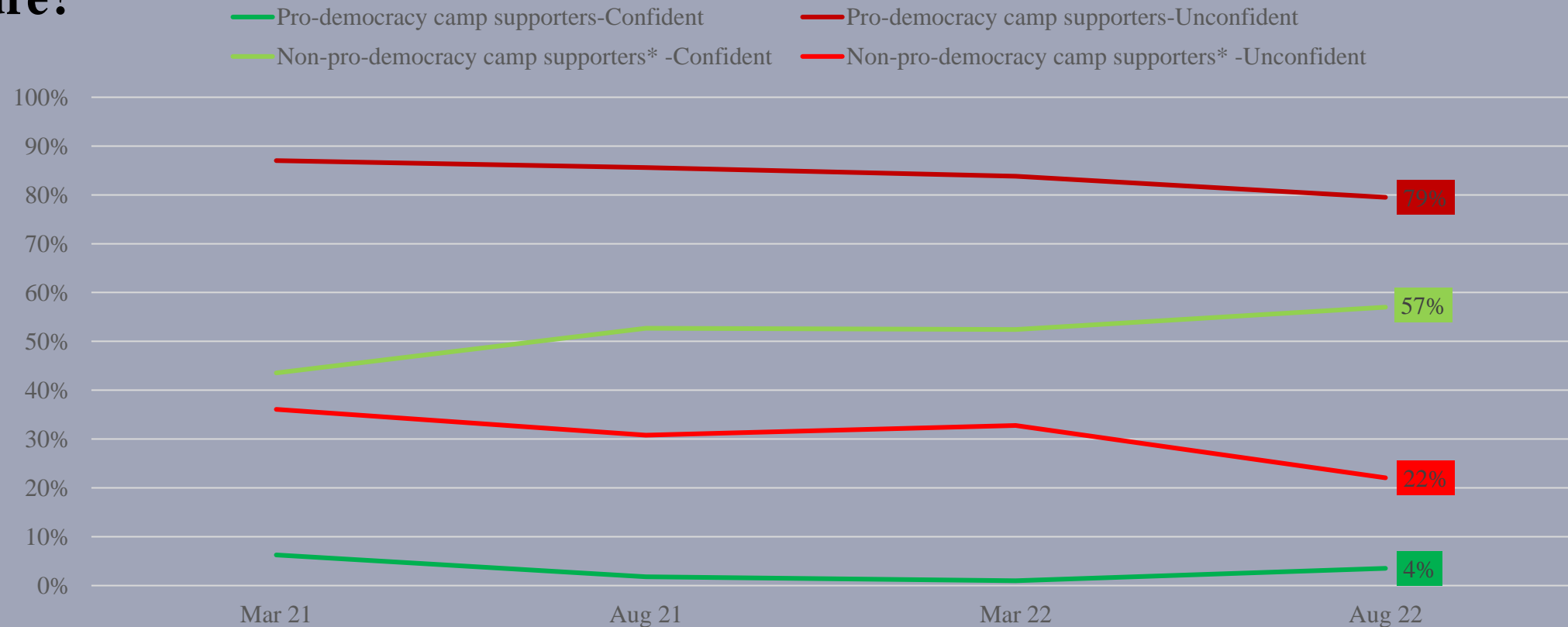

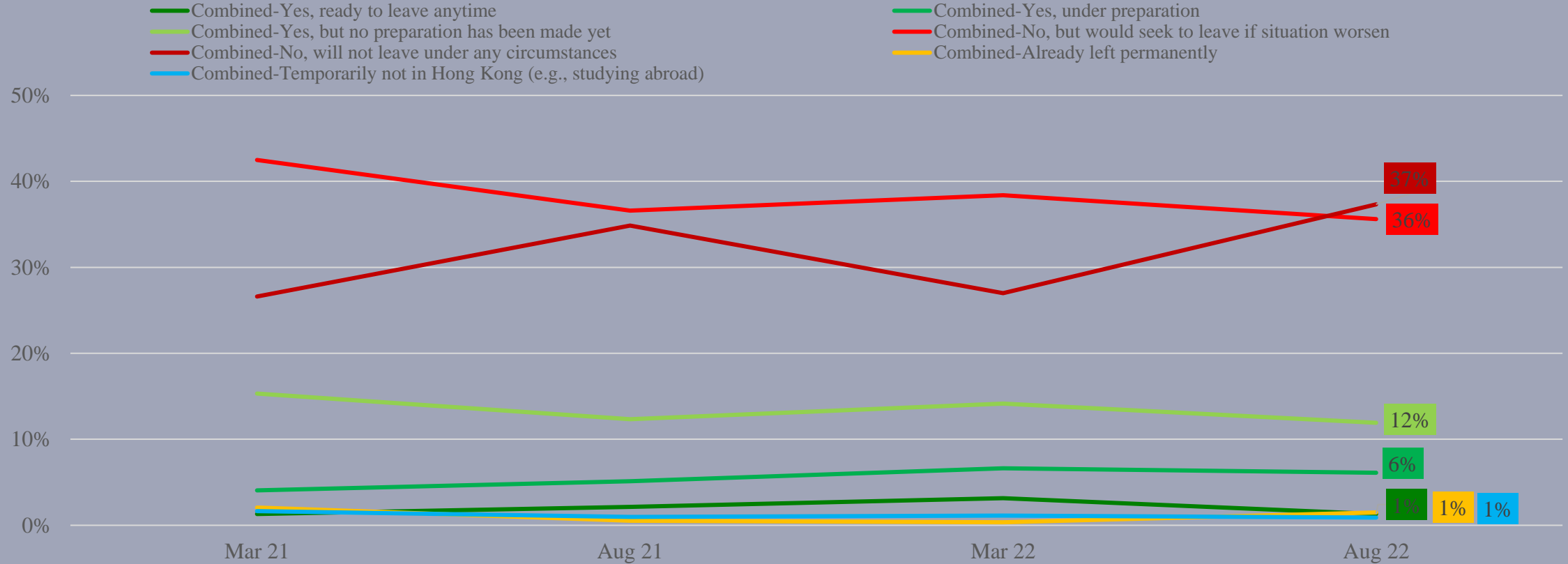

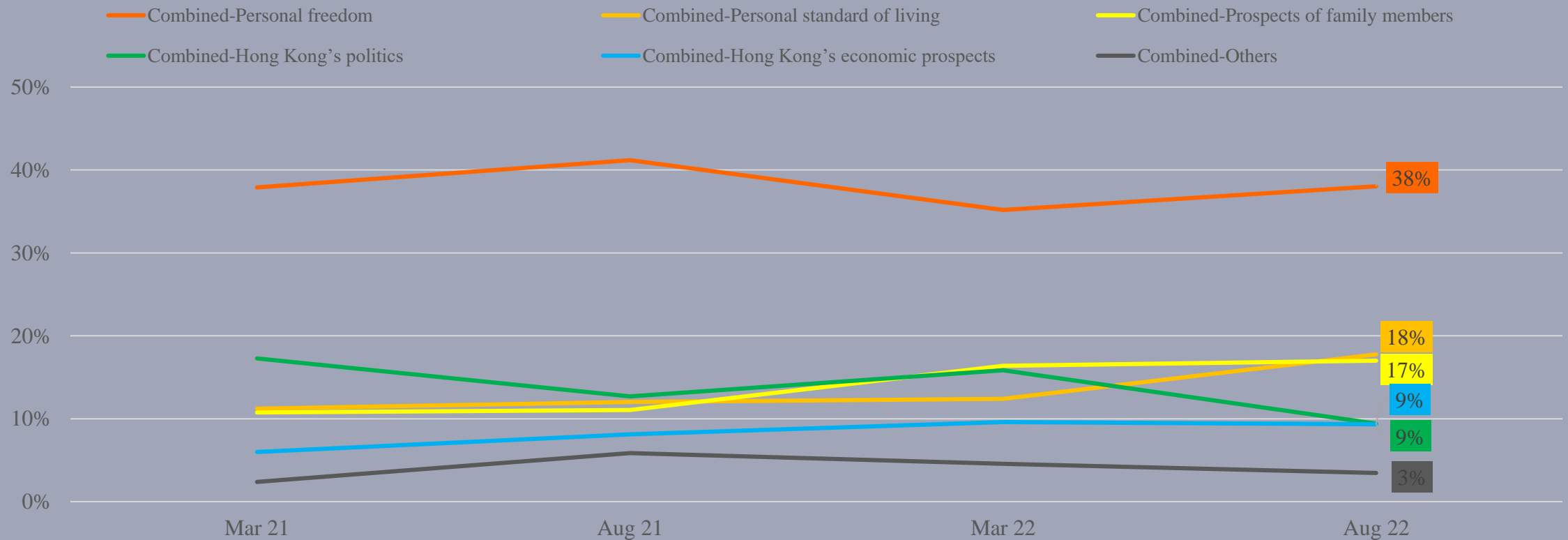

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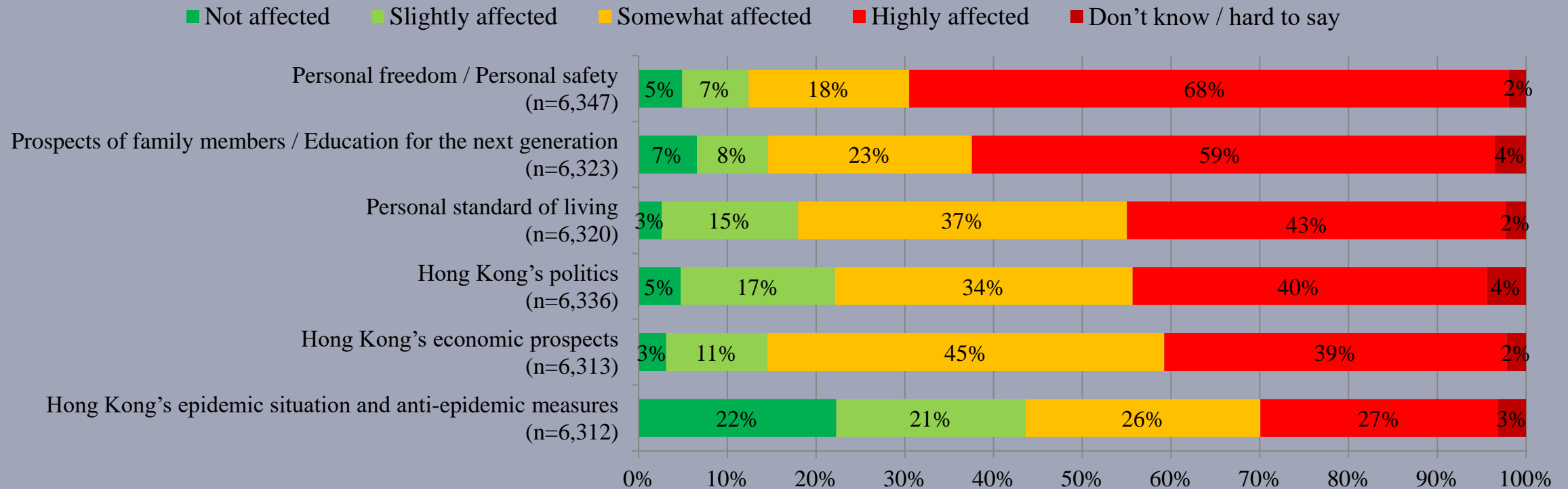

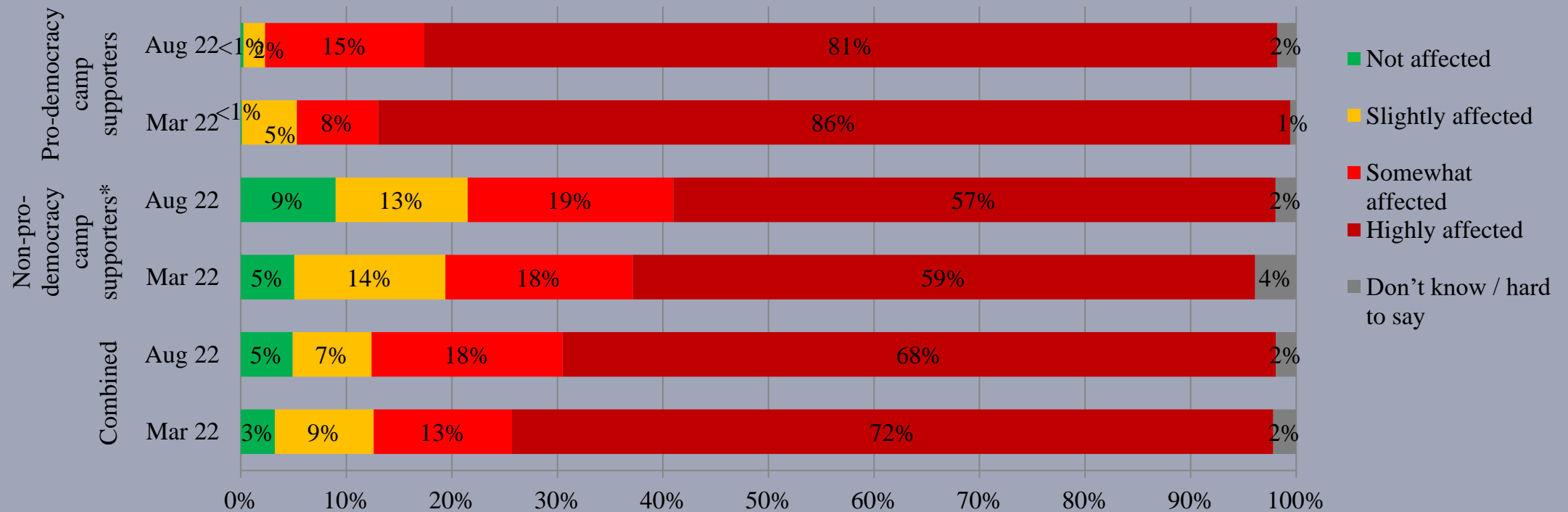

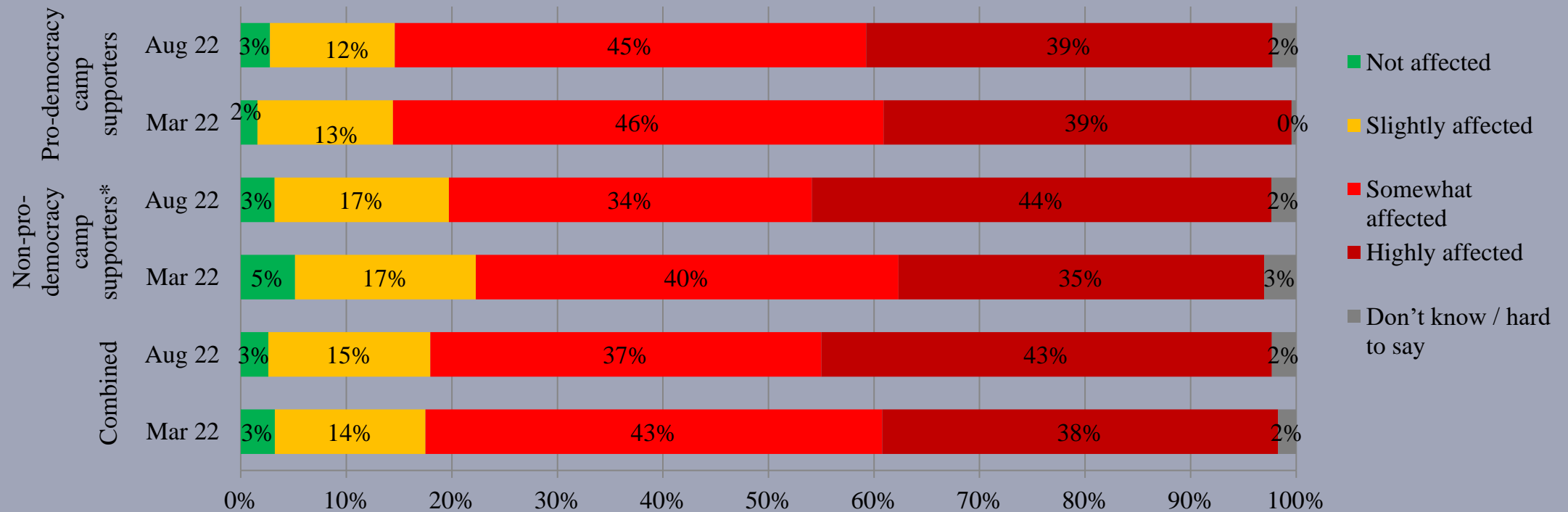

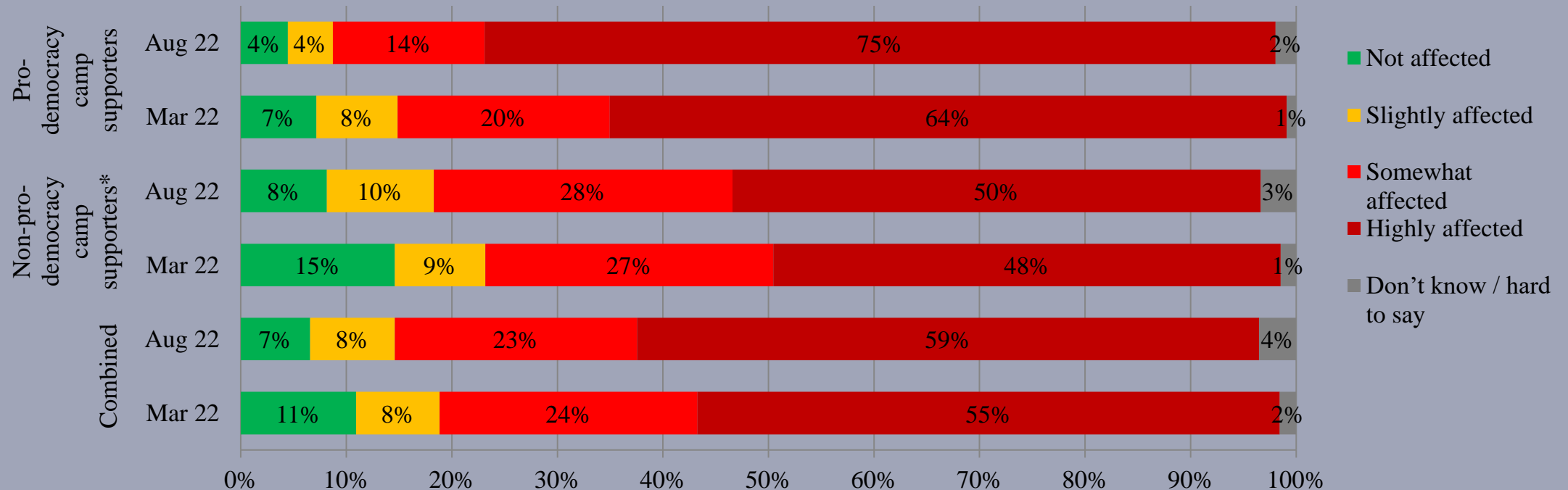

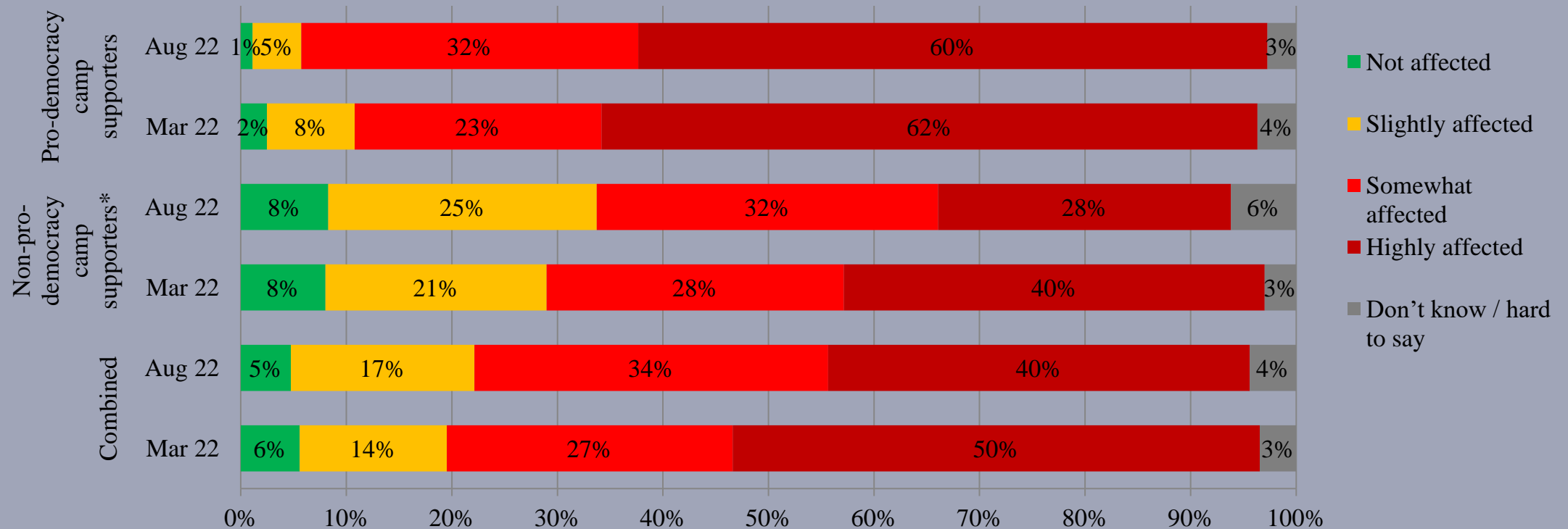

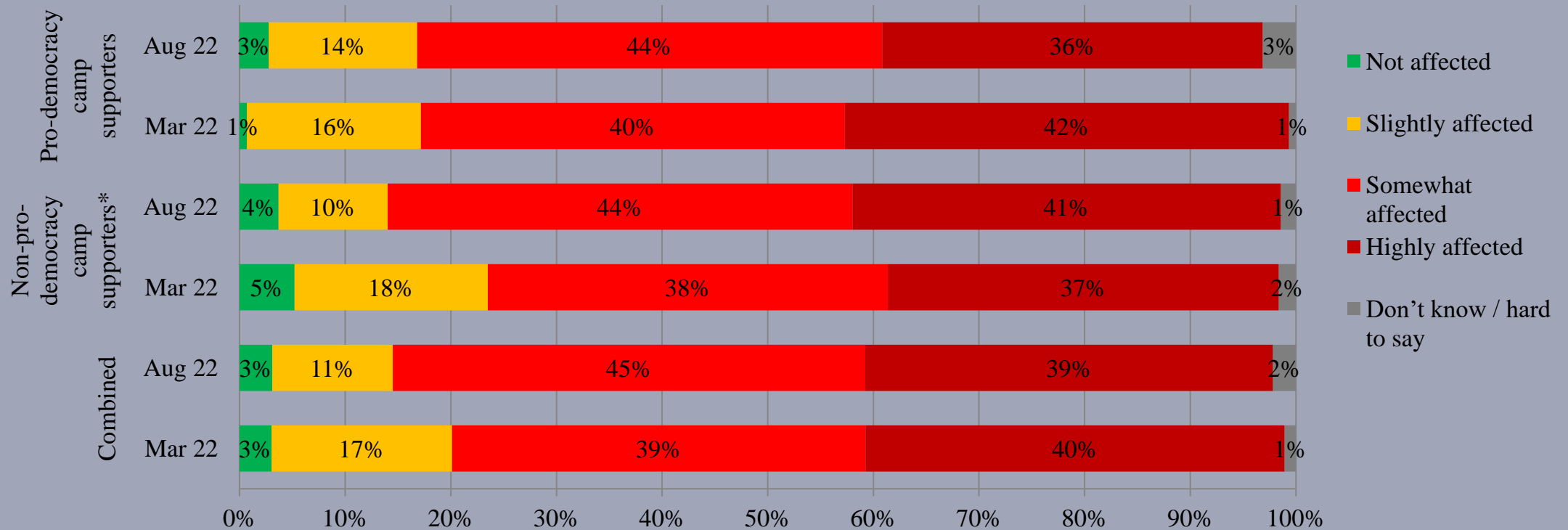

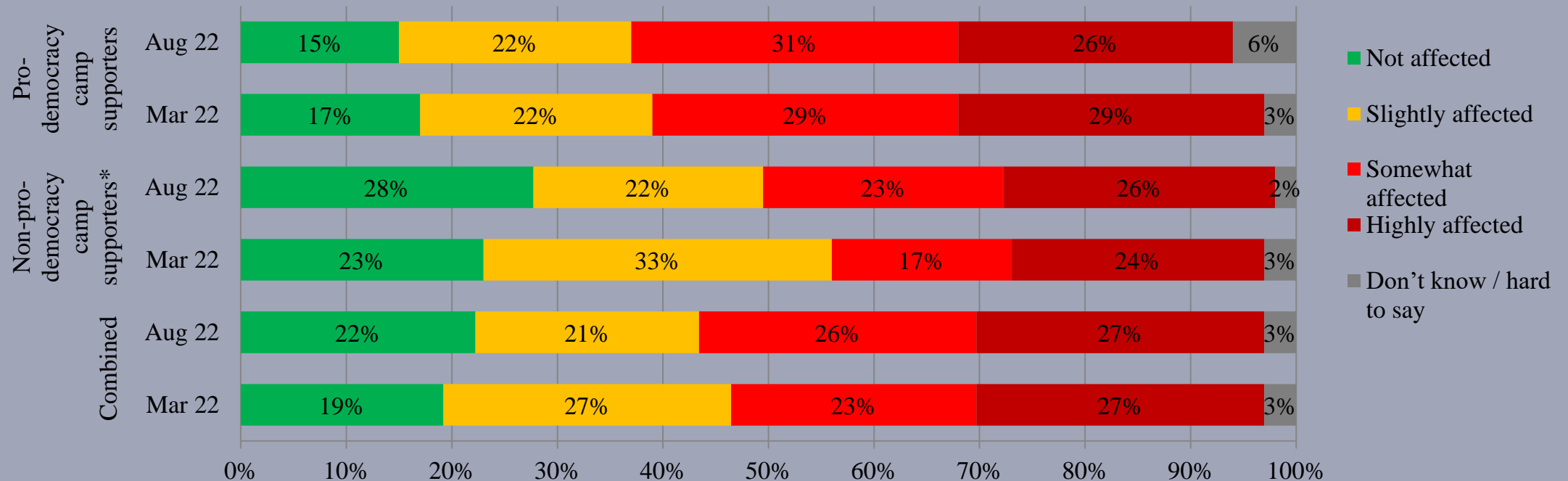
