### 香港民研發放今日最新限聚指數

#### 摘要

香港民研早於2020年4月21日啟動「疫後復工指數」先導計劃，目的是提供科學數據讓市民開始討論應該在什麼條件下恢復正常生活，包括工作、個人、家庭、社區和社會層面。及至2021年4月7日，香港民正式研啟動了「限聚指數」，旨在每天公佈市民對「限聚令」的最新接受程度及市民可接受的限聚人數。在經歷幾個月的測試後，香港民研證實市民對「限聚令」的看法並不會急速改變。因此，香港民研決定每一至兩個月或在政策有改變時才進行一次基準調查，而每日的指數只需在最新基準調查參照表中，查閱每日的確診個案數字即可。今天(2022年11月4日)最新「限聚指數」數值為**15.9**，並有**74%**市民認為現時「限聚令」太緊。

訪問對象	: 十二歲或以上的香港市民
總成功樣本	: 4,832
回應比率	: 5.7%
抽樣誤差 <sup>[1]</sup>	: 95%置信水平，百分比誤差+/-1%
加權方法	: 按照 1) 政府統計處提供的全港人口年齡及性別分佈、教育程度(最高就讀程度)及經濟活動身分統計數字；2) 常規調查中的政治狀況評價及政治取向分佈，以「反覆多重加權法」作出調整。

[1] 此公報中所有誤差數字均以 95%置信水平計算。95%置信水平，是指倘若以不同隨機樣本重複進行有關調查 100 次，則 95 次各自計算出的誤差範圍會包含人口真實數字。由於調查數字涉及抽樣誤差，傳媒引用百分比數字時，應避免使用小數點，在引用評分數字時，則可以使用一個小數點。

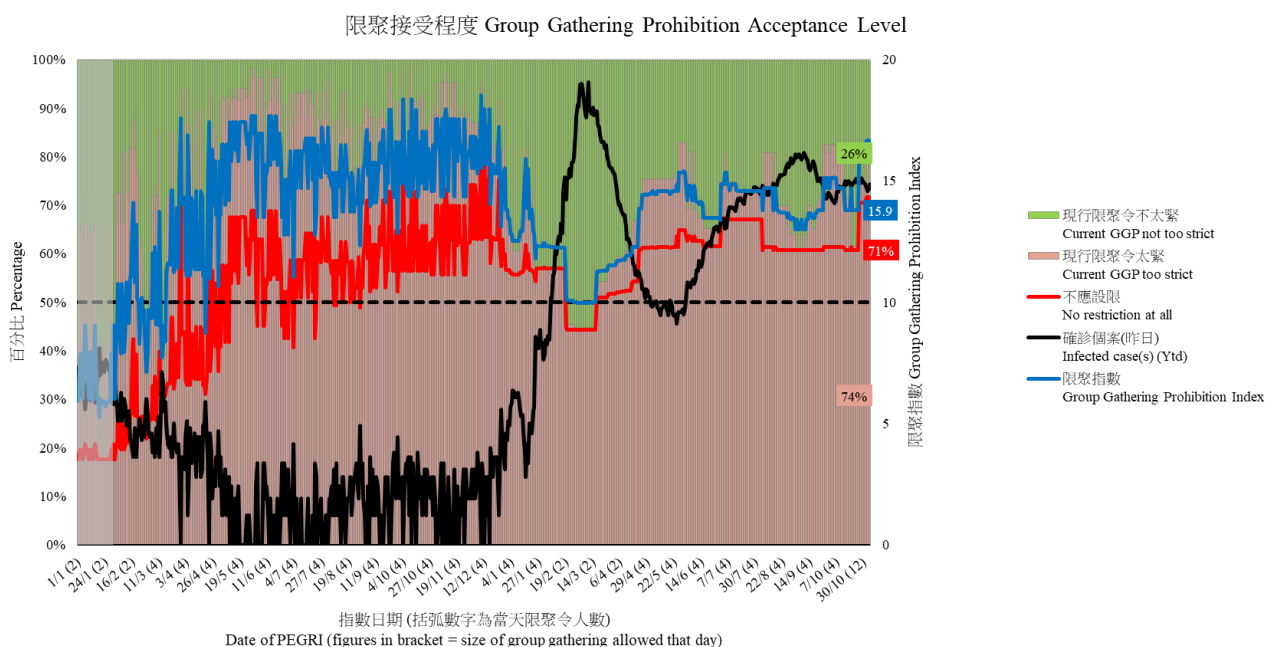

## 分析評論

獨立評論人潘麒智指出：「政府 11 月 3 日起再放寬防疫措施，燒烤場重開，餐廳食肆、表列處所的營業時間將不再受限制。限聚令人數亦由 4 人放寬至 12 人，與餐廳食肆 12 人一枱的人數上限一致；宴會人數上限維持 240 人；酒吧、夜店每檯人數限為 6 人，但出席宴會及到酒吧仍須快測陰性。政府早前已放寬旅客入境酒店檢疫要求，由 9 月 26 日起抵港人士檢疫隔離日數改為「0+3」，即不需酒店檢疫，只需進行 3 日家居醫學監察。事實上，市民更期待政府能夠為市民搬一次龍門，完全解除相關措施，讓香港能夠走向真正復常之路。」

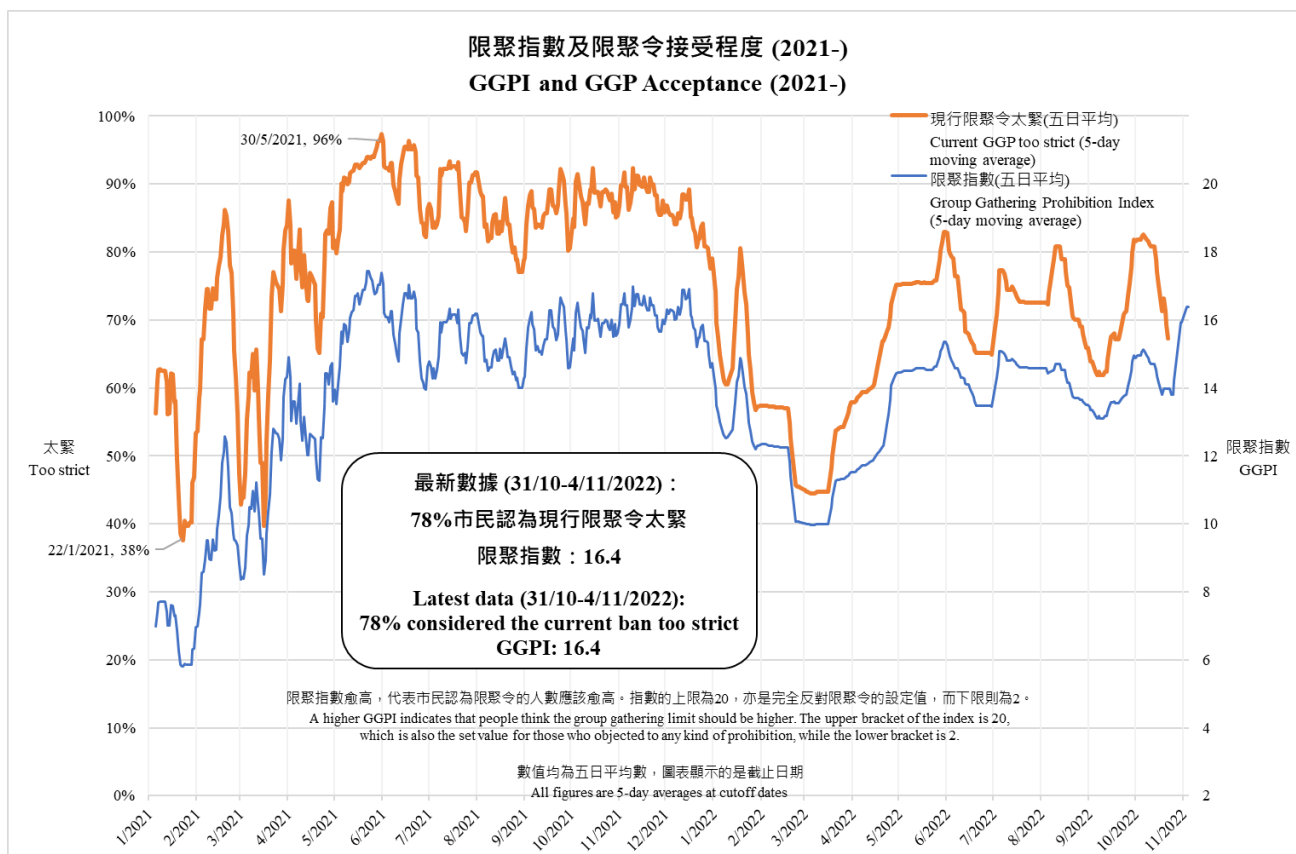

## Press Release on November 4, 2022

### PORI releases today the latest Group Gathering Prohibition Index

#### Abstract

As early as 21 April 2020, HKPORI piloted the “Post-Epidemic Work Resumption Index (PEWRI, 疫後復工指數)”, which aimed to provide scientific data for people to kick start their discussion under what conditions should everyday life go back to normal, including work, personal, family, community and societal domains. Then on 7 April 2021, PORI officially launched an index called “Group Gathering Prohibition Index (GGPI, 限聚指數)”, which aims to indicate people’s latest acceptance of the “Group Gathering Ban 限聚令” on a daily basis, along with their acceptance of various prohibition limits. Since the public’s view on the gathering ban has proven not to change rapidly after a few months’ test, PORI has decided to run benchmarking surveys only once every one to two month or whenever there are changes in the policy. Daily index figures can be obtained simply by checking on the table of index values versus the number of confirmed cases as compiled from the latest benchmark survey results. **GGPI stands at 15.9 today (4 November 2022), and 74% considered the current ban too strict.**

Sampling error <sup>[1]</sup>	: Sampling error of percentages at +/-1% at 95% confidence level
Weighting method	: Rim-weighted according to 1) gender-age distribution, educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution of Hong Kong population from Census and Statistics Department; 2) appraisal of political condition and political inclination distribution from regular tracking surveys.

[1] All error figures in this release are calculated at 95% confidence level. “95% confidence level” means that if we were to repeat a certain survey 100 times with different random samples, we would expect 95 times having the population parameter within the respective error margins calculated. Because of sampling errors, when quoting percentages, journalists should refrain from reporting decimal places, whereas one decimal place can be used when quoting rating figures.

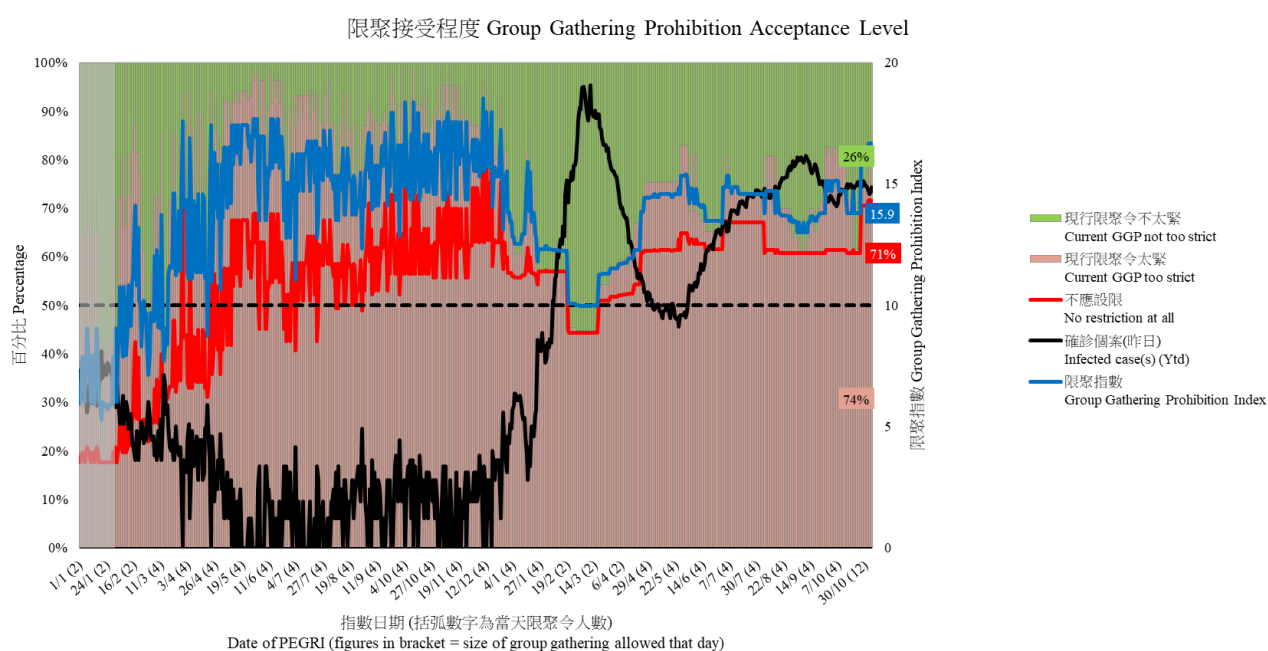

## Commentary

Independent commentator KC Poon observed, “The government relaxed the epidemic prevention measures again from November 3, barbecue sites reopened, restaurants and scheduled premises will no longer subject to business hours restrictions. The number of people allowed to gather is also relaxed from 4 to 12, in line with the maximum number of 12 people per table in restaurants; the maximum number of people for banquets is maintained at 240; the number of people per table in bars and nightclubs is limited to 6, but attendance at banquets and bars still requires a negative RAT test results. The government has earlier relaxed the quarantine requirements for tourists arriving at hotels, changing the number of quarantine days for arrivals to “0+3” from September 26, meaning that hotel quarantine is not required, but only 3 days of medical surveillance at home. In fact, the public expects the government to move the goalposts for the public once again, and completely lift the relevant measures, so that Hong Kong can move towards the road of real recovery.”
