### **Contact Information**

- Date of survey: 5-9/12/2022
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,004 (including 503 landline and 501 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 60.2%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from "Mid-year population for 2021", while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from "Women and Men in Hong Kong Key Statistics (2021 Edition)".

• Compared to 10 months ago, regardless of their popularity rankings, 8 political figures remain in the top 10. Sophia Chan and Henry Tang have fallen out of the list as replaced by Tam Yiu-chung and Starry Lee. The naming percentages for John Lee and Chris Tang have registered all-time personal record highs, while that of Tam Yiu-chung has registered a new record high since 2015.
