- Date of survey: 9-18/1/2023
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,000 (including 500 landline and 500 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 52.0%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4% and that of net values not more than +/-7% at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from "Mid-year population for 2021", while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from "Women and Men in Hong Kong Key Statistics (2021 Edition)".



Our latest survey shows that Hong Kong people feel more positively about all other peoples than their governments. Compared to half a year ago, the net affinity of Hong Kong people towards the peoples and governments have no significant change. Looking back at past records, the net affinity of Hong Kong people towards the peoples of Hong Kong and Macau have both registered historical highs since December 2007, while that towards their governments have registered new record highs since May 2008 and November 2006 respectively; the net affinity of Hong Kong people towards the government of Taiwan has somehow registered a new record low since November 2008.





