香港民研發放「一國兩制 25 周年中期民情總結」之政治團體民望

特別宣佈

香港民意研究所(香港民研)前身為香港大學民意研究計劃(港大民研)。公報內的「香港民研」指的可以是香港民意研究所或其前身港大民研。

香港民研在去年六月啟動「一國兩制 25 周年中期民情總結」,至今已發表了十八個調查系列的歷年數據總結。另外,由 2022 年下半年開始,我們將定期民意調查和記招的次數大幅縮減,改為集中資源進行公民教育工作。我們已在網站開展了「民研快訊」等新欄目,日後會繼續豐富內容,並逐漸增加服務項目。歡迎到我們的網站查看更多內容,並追蹤我們的Facebook、Instagram 和 Twitter 帳號,以獲得額外圖表和分析。

公報簡要

香港民研於二月初由真實訪問員以隨機抽樣電話訪問方式,分兩階段先後成功訪問了 500 及 518 名香港居民。

最新調查顯示,市民對政治團體的最新支持度排名,第一位是工聯會,得分為 48.5 分,第二位至第五位為民建聯、新民黨、自由黨和民主黨,分別得 46.0、42.6、42.0 及 40.2 分。另外,公民黨得 41.5 分,但由於認知率較低而被剔除。相比半年前,工聯會的評分顯著上升,並創 2014 年 6 月以來新高。民建聯的評分亦創 2015 年 5 月以來新高,而新民黨及自由黨則同創 2018 年 10 月以來新高。

調查的實效回應比率分別為 50.5%及 51.6%。在 95%置信水平下,調查的評分誤差不超過+/-2.8。

[2] 此公報中所有誤差數字均以 95%置信水平計算。95%置信水平,是指倘若以不同隨機樣本重複進行有關調查 100 次,則 95 次各自計算出的誤差範圍會包含人口真實數字。由於調查數字涉及抽樣誤差,傳媒引用百分比數字時,應避免使用小數點,在引用評分數字時,則可以使用一個小數點。

最新數據

在提名調查中,被訪者可在未經提示下說出最多 10 個最熟悉的政治團體,結果最多被訪者提及的政治團體分別是民建聯、民主黨、工聯會、新民黨、自由黨及公民黨。在評分調查中,被訪者就個別政治團體以 0 至 100 分進行評分,0 分代表絕對不支持,100 分代表絕對支持,50 分為一半半。統計結果後,認知度最低的一個再被剔除,之後再按支持度由高至低順序排列,得出五大政治團體。以下是五大政治團體的最新評分,按評分由高至低排列[3]:

須要說明,躋身「五大政團」的先決條件是市民的熟悉程度,然後再按支持度排名。「五大」 以外的政治團體,支持度可以很高或很低,但由於並非市民最熟悉的政團,所以不在榜內。



HKPORI wraps up popularity figures of political groups under "One Country Two Systems 25-year Mid-term Review"

Special Announcements

The predecessor of Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) was The Public Opinion Programme at The University of Hong Kong (HKUPOP). "HKPORI" in this release can refer to Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute or its predecessor HKUPOP.

HKPORI launched the "One Country Two Systems 25-year Mid-term Review" in June last year. Wrap up of the historical data of 18 survey series have been released since then. Meanwhile, starting from the second half of 2022, we have greatly reduced the frequency of our tracking polls and press conferences to channel our resources into civic education work. We have already launched some new columns, such as "PORI Express", in our website and will continue to enrich its content, then add more services. Please visit our website for more contents and follow us on Facebook, Instagram and Twitter to see extra charts and analyses.

Abstract

HKPORI successfully interviewed 500 and 518 Hong Kong residents respectively in two random telephone surveys conducted by real interviewers in early February.

Our latest survey shows that the most popularly supported political group is FTU with 48.5 marks, while DAB, New People's Party, Liberal Party and Democratic Party rank the 2nd to 5th with 46.0, 42.6, 42.0 and 40.2 marks respectively. In addition, Civic Party obtains a support rating of 41.5 marks, but it is dropped due to its relatively low recognition rate. Compared to half a year ago, the rating of FTU has increased significantly, registering a new record high since June 2014. The rating of DAB has registered a new record high since May 2015, while those of New People's Party and Liberal Party have also registered new record highs since October 2018.

The effective response rates of the surveys are 50.5% and 51.6% respectively. The maximum sampling error of ratings is \pm 2.8 at 95% confidence level.

Latest Figures

In the naming survey, respondents could name, unprompted, up to 10 political groups which they knew best. Democratic Alliance for the Betterment and Progress of Hong Kong (DAB), Democratic Party, Hong Kong Federation of Trade Unions (FTU), New People's Party, Liberal Party and Civic Party were the political groups mentioned most frequently. In the rating survey, respondents were asked to rate individual political groups using a 0-100 scale, where 0 indicates absolutely no support, 100 indicates absolute support and 50 means half-half. After calculation, the bottom political group in terms of recognition rate was dropped; the remaining 5 were then ranked according to their support ratings to become the top 5 political groups. Recent ratings of the top 5 political groups are summarized below, in descending order of support ratings^[3]:

^[3] If the rounded figures are the same, numbers after the decimal point will be considered.

^[2] All error figures in this release are calculated at 95% confidence level. "95% confidence level" means that if we were to repeat a certain survey 100 times with different random samples, we would expect 95 times having the population parameter within the respective error margins calculated. Because of sampling errors, when quoting percentages, journalists should refrain from reporting decimal places, whereas one decimal place can be used when quoting rating figures.

^[4] Numbers in curly brackets { } indicate the rankings.

- [5] The difference between the figure and the result from the previous survey has gone beyond the sampling error at 95% confidence level, meaning that the change is statistically significant prima facie. However, whether the difference is statistically significant is not the same as whether they are practically useful or meaningful, and different weighting methods could have been applied in different surveys.
- [6] Recognition rates were comparatively low in the rating survey.

Our latest survey shows that the most popularly supported political group is FTU with 48.5 marks, while DAB, New People's Party, Liberal Party and Democratic Party rank the 2nd to 5th with 46.0, 42.6, 42.0 and 40.2 marks respectively. In addition, Civic Party obtains a support rating of 41.5 marks, but it is dropped due to its relatively low recognition rate. It should be noted, however, that our list of "top 5" only includes political groups which are best known to the public, ranked according to their support ratings. Other political groups may well have very high or low support ratings, but because they are relatively less well-known, they are not included in our final list.
